Dear 49er's:

I have to apologize for this letter, it will be short. Clara Lo fell a couple a weeks ago and cracked her hip. She was first in the hospital and now in a nursing home where she can receive therapy. I am trying to help encourage her in this ordeal.

Wabash graduated 229 young men on May 17th. Twenty eight [28] seniors were inducted into the Wabash chapter of Phi Beta Kappa plus one junior-Adam Alexander from Yorktown, Indiana. The Class of 2015 includes a Rhodes Scholar, three Fulbright Scholarship winners, and three others who will serve fellowships overseas. More than 43 men will enroll in Ph.D. medical, law, and graduate schools. Four men will join Teach for America, while two others will serve in the AmeriCorps City Year program. Further, the class has 86 men who have already accepted full-time employment or postgraduate internships.

Construction on the new living units is moving along. I have asked Michele Ward, again to include photos of the construction site. Two units are to be ready for occupancy by August 15th.





The 2015 Big Bash was a success. The class of 1965 set a new 50th attendance record of 76, also made a class gift of \$5.5M. I say WOW!

I would like to encourage every classmate to give Wabash their support. Wabash is a juncture, where we have to provide top faculty, living units, and athletic facilities, to attract young men to Wabash. It is highly competitive for these young men, but Wabash Always Fights.
