Wabash College's Sebastian Garren has earned a Fulbright Scholarship to pursue postgraduate work in educational policy in Finland.

Garren '14, a native of St. Louis, Mo., was awarded the study/research grant and will enroll this fall in the master's degree program in Learning, Learning Environments and Education Systems (LLEES) at the University of Turku in Turku, Finland. Educational policy has long been a focus for Garren and he selected Finland for postgraduate study because it has one of the finest educational systems in the world.

There are some special athletes at Wabash. Riley Lefever is a freshman and has had an undefeated wrestling season in the 184 lb. class. 41-0 record and a NCAA Division III National Title. Riley's older brother Reese [a junior] earned a fourth place finish at 157 pounds and earns All America honors for the second time. The first time was in 2013.



The Wabash track team set a new record for total points at the 2014 North Coast Athletic Conference Indoor Track and Field held at Denison. Wabash College head track and field coach **Clyde Morgan** and assistant coach **Roger Busch** received men's indoor regional coaching honors from the US Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches Association.
