Dear Men and Women of '57:

Wabash College continues educating young men with great success.

Following summarizes some 2013 College events/changes:

- \* The Class of 2013 graduated 190 men (24 cum laude, 17 magna cum laude and 14 summa cum laude).
- \* The Teacher Education Program is now the Education Studies Department.
- \* The Campus is well maintained and impressive to visit.
- \* Student retention improved with 38 % fewer students declared academically ineligible to return.
- \* September 30, 2013 the Endowment was \$330 million.
- \* Faculty members use technology to deliver lecture content online and through videos, thus using classrooms for discussion and problem solving.
- \* President Pat White and wife, Chris, left Wabash after seven years to become interim President at Millikin University and later elected President of Millikin.
- \* President Gregory D. Hess became the 16th President of Wabash College his Inauguration was on October 11th.

- \* Dr. Gary Phillips announced that he will step down as Dean of the College, after 8 years of service at the end of the current fiscal year and will join the Religion Department.
- \* Dr. Scott E. Feller will be the next Dean of the College. He has been a chemistry professor since 1998. He will begin his duties July 1, 2014.
- \* 4633 alumni, parents and friends gave \$3,326,272 for last year's Annual Fund. Alumni participation was 37.2% in fiscal year 2013 vs 35.0% for 2012.
- \* There were 902 students beginning the 2013-14 school year, including 245 students in the class of 2017.
- \* The football team was 9-1, including retaining the Monon Bell (5 in a row); cross country team won Regionals.
