Thank you for supporting Wabash College---more than 4400 alumni, friends, faculty and staff contributed over \$3,104, 000 for the 2007-2008 fiscal year!

Wabash football is off to a good start this fall. Coach Erik Raeburn prepared the team for its first win September 13th over NCAC rival at Denison 41 – 27 and defeated the University of Chicago September 20th 49 - 7. Wabash was picked 11th in Division III by D3football.com and 2nd after Wittenberg by the NCAC coaches.
