All reports from Crawfordsville are encouraging with our new President Greg Hess fully at work. The College seems to be accepting the Leadership adjustments with enthusiasm. The Sports Teams have had an eventful Spring- in particular the Track and Field Team has captured the NCAC Championship and produced several All Americans. Baseball and Tennis both had good experience this spring and Lacrosse is ready for full NCAA competition in 2015. Very exciting for Joe Haklin and his team in the Athletic Center.

Wabash continues to work diligently to provide a true College experience for the now 900 plus undergraduates. International travel and immersion trips have added greatly as has the diversity of the student body. The education is strong as is the makeup of the student body.

During the 176th Commencement, 172 young men received their diplomas. Three of them are Fulbright Fellows and 34 will enroll in medical, law and other graduate schools. Two of the Fulbright Fellows are going to Spain to teaching English. The other man will spend a year in Finland in a master's program in learning, Learning Environments and Educational Systems.
