Sometimes writing comes easy. Not today, as it's with great sadness I report to you the loss of another one of our classmates, Greg Bussard of Huntington.

Greg was a physics major, a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon, a multi-sport athlete, and a great guy with the driest sense of humor and most calm perspective of almost anyone I've known. His disposition was distinctively sweet-tempered and sunny. He did three sports at the beginning of his time at the college, lettered in wrestling, but made his mark as a defensive back on the football team. He was an original member of the "Crunch Bunch" defensive secondary which helped turn around the fortunes of the Little Giants.

You remember the IFC's "Bicentennial Beard Growing" contest in 1976? Greg was one of the winners of that. You recall when cycling was an intramural sport? Greg biked a leg of the winning relay team for TKE.

In more recent years, Greg was a pastor, leader and spiritual mentor to many at Bethel United Methodist Church in Huntington. He was a frequent returning face in the crowd at Wabash football games, and his presence always emanated contentment and peace.



He was a caring soul. He died while preparing for service at Bethel Church on Sunday. "Promoted to the church triumphant in heaven," is how one of my former pastors would describe Greg today.
