Football Season Ends In Quarterfinals

Wabash College ended its season 12-1 after being defeated 38-7 in the national semifinals by the St. Thomas Tommies of Saint Paul, Minnesota. With an NCAC Conference Championship, seventh-straight Bell win, and national quarterfinals appearance the season was considered a success. Wabash senior Mason Zurek was named D3football.com North Region Offensive Player of the Year and Little Giants head coach Erik Raeburn received Regional Coach of the Year honors. Nine Wabash players were selected 2015 All-North Region Team. Joining Zurek and Raeburn are first team selections Tyler McCullen (DT) and Andrew Tutsie (K), as well as second team picks Kyle Stucker (C), Wes Brown (T), Ethan Buresh (DE), Connor Ludwig (LB), Delon Pettiford (CB), and Austin Brown (S).

CAMPUS SERVICES WINS NATIONAL HONOR

Campus Services won a national honor from the Professional Grounds Management Society for keeping the campus looking its best. Wabash won a Green Star Honor Award in the small college and grounds category. Only seven national colleges were honored. The Green Star competition brings national recognition to grounds maintained with a 'high degree of excellence, and complements other national landscape award programs that recognize outstanding design and construction.' Wabash College Director of Campus Services gave much of the credit to Grounds Manager, Tim Riley for the submission and the outstanding program he has developed over the years.
