Gamma Delta chapter house until their \$4 million, 40-man house is completed in time for the 2008-2009 academic year.

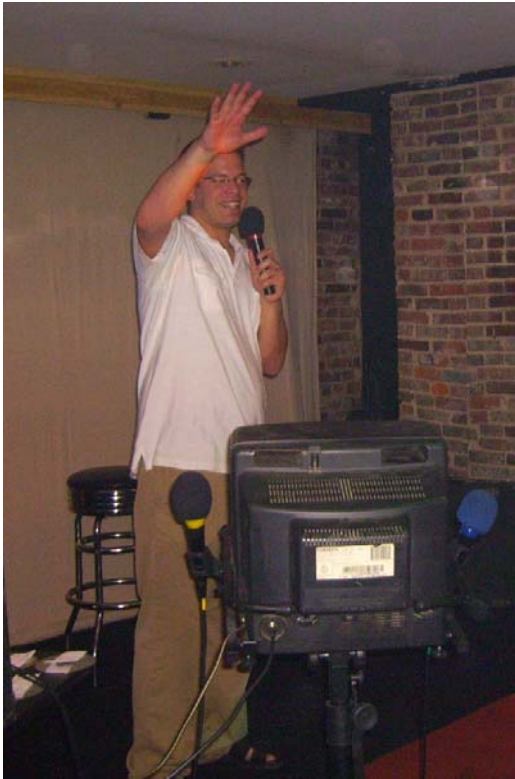
Construction to renovate and transform the old TKE house has been underway since spring break. The new facility will be called College Hall and will be a 70-man independent residence hall ready for occupation this August.
