WABASH FOOTBALL TO CELEBRATE SENIOR DAY SATURDAY

Crawfordsville, IN - Wabash College (7-1, 5-1 NCAC) plays its final North Coast Athletic Conference game of the 2009 season Saturday when the Little Giants play Hiram College (0-8, 0-5 NCAC). Kickoff at Hollett Little Giant Stadium (5,000; natural grass) is set for 1 p.m.

Eighteen senior members of the 2009 Wabash football team will be honored for their accomplishments prior to Saturday's kickoff.

SERIES RECORD: Wabash holds a 5-0 advantage in the all-time series against the Terriers.

LAST YEAR: Wes Chamblee (JR/WR/South Bend, IN/St. Joseph) opened the game with a 91-yard kickoff return in an eventual 63-0 win by the Little Giants. Wabash tallied 565 yards of total offense on 64 plays, including a season-high 365 rushing yards.

LAST WEEK: Matt Hudson (SR/QB/Salem, IN/Salem) returned to the starting lineup after missing two starts with a rib injury to throw for 320 yards and three touchdowns in the Little Giants' 41-9 win at Oberlin. Wabash got off to a slow start, leading 7-3 at halftime before scoring 27 points in the third quarter. Geoffrey Wright (SO/WR/Vernon, IN/Jennings County) scored his first career touchdown on a 25-yard reception from Hudson to start the third quarter blitz. Sam Smith (SO/DB/Bloomington, IL/Normal) and Derek Rowe (FR/RB/Logansport, IN/Logansport) also scored their first career touchdowns in the win.

COACHES: Erik Raeburn (Mount Union, 1994) is in his second season as the head coach of the Little Giants after posting a 10-2 mark in his first year. He came to Wabash after spending eight seasons at Coe College in Iowa, giving him an overall coaching record of 74-29 in 10 seasons as a head coach. Raeburn was an assistant coach at Mount Union College from 1994-1999. He is 1-0 versus Hiram.

Bob Wolfe (Bowling Green, 1969) is in his third season as the head football coach at Hiram with a record of 3-25 and an overall mark of 44-87-3 in 13 seasons as a head coach. He is 0-1 versus Wabash.

RANKINGS: Wabash moved up two spots to 16th in the D3football.com poll and three places to 16th in the American Football Coaches Association poll, as well. The Little Giants moved up one place to sixth in the latest NCAA North Region rankings.

TELEVISION/INTERNET: Hometown Television will broadcast all five home games on the Wabash football schedule. The games will be available live over the Internet and will air Monday nights following a home game at 6 p.m. on HomeTown Sports Indiana TV 81. The live Internet feed is free of charge through Teamline at www.teamline.cc. Joe Emmick '92 and Steve Hoffman '85 will announce the game. The Internet broadcasts are sponsored by the Shelbourne Knee Center.

RADIO: Wabash football can be heard on WNDY Radio (91.3 FM) all season long. Ben Humphreys '10, Nate Kring '10, and Mark Maxwell will announce Saturday's game. The pregame show begins at 12:40 p.m. The broadcast is carried on the Internet on the Wabash College web site, www.wabash.edu/sports and on Teamline at www.teamline.cc.

LEMOND CLOSING IN ON 1,000 YARDS AGAIN

Junior wide receiver **Kody LeMond (Pendleton, IN/Pendleton Heights)** enters Saturday's game with 50 catches for a total of 864 receiving yards, putting him 136 away from reaching 1,000 for the second consecutive season.

LeMond set Wabash and North Coast Athletic Conference single-season receiving yardage records with 1,228 yards on 73 catches. If he reaches the 1,000-yard mark this year, he will become the first player in both Little Giant and NCAC history to accomplish the feat twice in a career in addition to becoming the first to do so in back-to-back seasons. He also enters the week ranked seventh on the Wabash career receiving yardage list with 2,169.

COACH RAEURN'S COMMENTS

"We really didn't come out with the same energy or focus against Oberlin that we have had against other teams this season. I hope we learned that if you do that as a team, Oberlin played hard and executed all game long. We really didn't until the third quarter and were very fortunate to pull out the win. We got our act together at halftime and came out and played like we're capable of playing."

On Hiram: "Hiram has certainly struggled with some things this season, but if we learned anything from last week it's that if you don't come ready to play, any football team can beat you. I hope our players understand no matter who we play, if we don't have that same energy level and we're not concentrating and focusing on our assignments, then we'll have our hands full Saturday."

On the Seniors: "I think the impact of this senior class has been significant to our program. We have a great bunch of seniors. They have all been a part of three conference championships. The leadership they have provided cannot be measured. They've provided energy in practices and games. They've been a great resource during the transition of our program and have kept the winning tradition of Wabash football in place."

HIRAM PREVIEW

The Terriers come to Crawfordsville Saturday with an 0-8 record, but have been steadily improving on both sides of the football. Hiram ranks second in the conference and 11th in the nation in pass defense, holding opponents to 129.88 yards per game. **Jon Hull (SO/LB/6-2/198/Buford, GA/Mill Creek)** leads the defensive unit with 63 total tackles. **Humphrey Caswell (SR/DL/6-0/285/South Euclid, OH/Brush)** has 45 total stops, including seven tackles for losses totaling 24 yards and two sacks for 15 yards. **Brandon Jackson (JR/FS/6-0/185/Akron, OH/Buchtel)**, **Stephen Offutt (JR/OLB/5-10/200/Twinsburg, OH/Twinsburg)**, and **Mike Brown (SO/CB/5-9/158/Cleveland, OH/Glenville Academy Center)** each have an interception for the Terriers.

Offensively, freshman quarterback **Brendan Rehor (5-11/170/Bay Village, OH/Bay)** has gone through some growing pains in his first season. He has thrown for 983 yards and five TDs on 116-of-210 passing, but has also tossed 15 interceptions in eight games. **Glenn Campbell (JR/WR/6-0/180/Akron, OH/Buchtel)** tops the receiving list for Hiram with 41 catches for 432 yards and four scores. **Kyle Callari (FR/6-2/175/Medina, OH/Highland)** has added 30 receptions for 357 yards and one touchdown, as well.

Chris Austin (FR/TB/5-8/180/Cleveland, OH/Glenville) is the leading rusher for the Terriers with 97 carries for 292 yards and one TD. **Rodney Jacobs (SO/TB/6-1/215/St. Petersburg, FL/Seminole)** averages 40.2 yards per game as the backup to Austin with 241 yards and one touchdown on 59 attempts.

RED PACK TAKE SECOND NCAC CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Wabash cross country team was picked to finish second by the North Coast Athletic Conference coaches, and delivered on that selection Saturday with a solid team effort at the championship meet held in Delaware, Ohio.

The finish was the best for the Little Giants since joining the NCAC in 1999. Wabash finished third in 2008, 2007, 2005, 2001, and 1999.

Junior **Seth Einterz (Zionsville, IN/Zionsville)** and sophomore **Kevin McCarthy (Zionsville, IN/Zionsville)** broke up the pack from Allegheny to take fourth and fifth place respectively, while fellow sophomore **Donavan White (Indianapolis, IN/Ben Davis)** returned from injury to score a 14th-place finish.

Einterz posted his fastest time of the season, finishing the 8000 meters in 26:07.7. He earned First Team All-NCAC recognition for the second consecutive year to become a three-time conference honoree. McCarthy was a fraction behind his teammate, crossing the finish line 26:08.00 to receive First Team All-NCAC honors, as well. The duo finished 14 seconds behind race winner Jeremie Parker from Allegheny, who won with a time of 25:53.0.

White missed much of the 2009 season with a foot injury, but worked throughout the fall to be able to return for the conference meet. He finished 27:13.6 to earn a spot on the All-NCAC Second Team.

Wabash moved back into the US Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association regional poll after its second-place finish, re-entering the Great Lakes Region rankings in sixth place.

Next Meet: The Little Giants are off until November 14 when they will compete at the NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional at the Gibson Family Cross Country Circuit in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Wabash loaded the bus Friday afternoon for a weekend of dual meet competition last week. The Little Giants lost to Kalamazoo College 170-126 Friday night in South Bend before traveling to Bloomington, Illinois Saturday for a double-dual meet against Illinois Wesleyan and Rose-Hulman. Wabash defeated both teams, winning 96-42 over IWU and 99-41 against Rose-Hulman.

Elijah Sanders (SR/Mt. Vernon, IN/Mt. Vernon) had a great weekend in the distance events, recording three victories Friday night against Kalamazoo and a fourth on Saturday in the double-dual meet at IWU. He won the 1000 freestyle Saturday with a time of 10:32.49 less than 24 hours after posting victories in the 1000 free (10:21.51), the 500 free (4:53.00), and the 400 individual medley (4:24.41). **Craig Vektor (SR/Indianapolis, IN/Franklin Central)** added two individual first place finishes and two relay victories. He won the 200 free Friday night (1:45.21) and picked up a win in the 100 free on Saturday (48.70). Vektor was part of the Little Giants' winning 200 medley (1:40.33) and 200 free relays (1:30.21) in Saturday's double-dual meet.

Next Meets: The Little Giants return to action Friday evening with a dual meet in South Bend, Indiana. Wabash will compete against the Kalamazoo College men's team at 7 p.m. Saturday, the Little Giants will compete against Illinois Wesleyan and Rose-Hulman in a double-dual meet in Bloomington, Illinois at 1 p.m.

The Wabash soccer team was a win away from earning its first trip to the NCAC Men's Soccer Tournament when Oberlin's Skyler Dum recorded a hat trick in the season finale to dash any chance for Wabash to make postseason play. The Little Giants rallied from a 2-0 deficit with back-to-back goals with less than 20 minutes left in the match. **Ryan Fier (FR/MF/Columbus, IN/Columbus North)** recorded his third goal of the season with a score in the 72nd minute. Three minutes later **Femi Oluyedun (SO/F/Westfield, IN/International School of Indiana)** scored the equalizer on a shot across the front of the goal for his team-best ninth goal of the season. Dum's goal in the 103rd minute gave Oberlin the victory and ended a successful season for the Little Giants.

Wabash had to rally for a 4-3 victory in Wednesday's win at Earlham. After early goals by **Mark Babcock (JR/D/Chesterton, IN/Chesterton)**, **Allan Swan (SO/MF/Glasgow, Scotland/Carmel)**, and Oluyedun, Earlham tied the score in the second half. Sophomore **Austin Jennings (F/Noblesville, IN/Noblesville)** scored the game-winner with 12 minutes left in the match for his sixth goal of the year.

Wabash finishes the season with a record of 9-9-1 and 4-5 in the NCAC. The Little Giants posted the most wins since tallying 11 victories in 1998. Wabash also finished .500 or better for the first time since that season.
