FINAL 2009 NCAC ROAD TRIP PUTS WABASH AT OBERLIN

Crawfordsville, IN - Wabash College (6-1, 4-1 NCAC) plays its final North Coast Athletic Conference road game of the season Saturday when the Little Giants head to Oberlin College (1-6, 1-3 NCAC). Kickoff at Savage Stadium (3,500; natural grass) is set for 1 p.m.

Wabash is undefeated on the road this season, outscoring opponents 122-40 away from Hollett Little Giant Stadium. Wabash has won 11 consecutive conference road games, dating back to a 19-17 loss at Wittenberg in 2006 when the Little Giants missed a field goal attempt on the final play of the game. The overall road winning streak for Wabash stands at nine, with the last loss coming in the quarterfinals of the 2007 NCAA Division III playoffs at Wisconsin-Whitewater.

SERIES RECORD: Wabash owns an 11-1-1 advantage in the all-time series against the Yeomen. Oberlin defeated Wabash 32-7 in the first meeting between the two school in 1945. The 1947 Homecoming game at Wabash ended in a 7-7 tie. Since then, Wabash has won the last 11 meetings, including all nine conference contests.

LAST YEAR: Wabash scored on its first seven possessions against an injury-depleted Oberlin team to claim a 60-7 victory. The Little Giants amassed a season-high 546 yards of total offense. Matt Hudson (SR/QB/Salem, IN/Salem) and Josh Miracle (JR/QB/Hobart, IN/Hobart) combined for 277 passing yards in the win.

LAST WEEK: Chase Belton (FR/QB/Dayton, OH/Northmont) threw for 283 yards and four touchdowns in his starting debut for Wabash, leading the Little Giants to a 37-27 victory at Wooster. Belton fired all four touchdown passes to Kody LeMond (JR/WR/Pendleton, IN/Pendleton Heights), who finished with 10 receptions for 197 yards to become the eighth Wabash receiver to reach the 2,000 career receiving yards mark. Kenny Coggins (SR/DE/Tulsa, OK/Metro Christian) recorded his first career interception and touchdown on the same play when he grabbed a Wooster pass deep in Scots' territory and returned it nine yards to put Wabash up 10-7.

COACHES: Erik Raeburn (Mount Union, 1994) is in his second season as the head coach of the Little Giants after posting a 10-2 mark in his first year. He came to Wabash after spending eight seasons at Coe College in Iowa, giving him an overall coaching record of 73-29 in 10 seasons as a head coach. Raeburn was an assistant coach at Mount Union College from 1994-1999. He is 1-0 versus Oberlin.

Jeff Ramsey (UC-Davis, 1983) is in his 11th season as the head football coach at Oberlin with a record of 27-80. He is 0-9 versus Wabash.

RANKINGS: Wabash remained 18th in the D3football.com poll and moved up two spots to 19th in the American Football Coaches Association poll.

RADIO: Wabash football can be heard on WNDY Radio (91.3 FM) all season long. Brent Harris and Tom Coyle will announce Saturday's game. The pregame show begins at 12:40 p.m. The broadcast is carried on the Internet on the Wabash College web site, www.wabash.edu/sports and on Teamline at www.teamline.cc.

## LEMOND EARNS WEEKLY HONORS

Junior wide receiver **Kody LeMond (Pendleton, IN/Pendleton Heights)** was named the North Coast Athletic Conference Offensive Football Player of the Week and to the *D3football.com* Team of the Week, presented by Scoutware.

LeMond caught four touchdown passes in Saturday's victory at Wooster — tying the Wabash and NCAC single-game records. The effort also tied LeMond's personal-best effort after catching four TD passes against Kenyon in 2008.

LeMond made 10 receptions for a season-high 197 yards against Wooster, making him the eighth Wabash football player to record more than 2,000 receiving yards in a career, reaching that mark in just 23 games — faster than any other Wabash football player. He is currently seventh on the Little Giants' all-time receiving yardage list with 2,084. He trails **Eric Snively '94** in sixth place with 2,227. **Mike Funk '89** is the all-time leader with 2,858 receiving yards. LeMond also moved to fifth on the all-time touchdown receptions list with 25. He trails **Mike Russell '08** and **Kurt Casper '02** in third place with 27 apiece.

## MONON BELL TICKETS NEARLY GONE

Less than 850 Wabash tickets remain for the 116th Monon Bell Classic. The annual rivalry game between Wabash College and DePauw University will take place Saturday, November 14 at Blackstock Stadium in Greencastle, Indiana.

Wabash tickets are \$15 per person and can be purchased online or in person from the Wabash College Bookstore. A \$10 shipping fee will be added to online purchases to insure delivery in time for the game.

Gates will open on November 14 at 11:30 a.m. Stadium lots will open at 9 a.m., a change from the initial information printed on the tickets. A \$5 parking fee will be charged for tailgating events held in either the Blackstock Stadium or the Peeler Art Center (RVs) lots.

The 116th Monon Bell Classic will be broadcast live throughout the country on HDNet (DirecTV Channel 79, DISH Network Channel 9422, and on various cable television outlets throughout the country).

## COACH RAEURN'S COMMENTS

"There are elements of the offense, defense, and special teams through the first seven games that haven't been executed properly. Now you are to the point of the season that you're trying to work on those things. Injuries have obviously been a factor for us this year, too. We're making certain in practice that we're getting guys plenty of reps in practice so they can step up if need, just as **Chase (Belton)** did Saturday at Wooster."

**On Oberlin:** "Oberlin has really changed some things up this year. They are playing two different styles of defense from last year, and have changed a lot of what they're doing on offense. They have been solid on defense the last few games after struggling a little at the start of the season. They have eliminated the big plays that plagued them early. They are making offensive teams drive the length of the field, which is very difficult to do consistently. We'll have to have a lot of discipline and patience. That's what has helped Oberlin the last few games. They have eliminated those mistakes and are starting to take advantage of the mistakes of their opponents. They take good care of the football on offense and have put themselves in good position to win their last two football games."

**On the play of Chase Belton:** "I was really happy with the way Chase played, particularly when you think about the circumstances — first start, on the road, facing a good team, a must-win game for your team. I was really happy with the way he responded. I think he felt really good having **Matt (Hudson)** and **Josh (Miracle)** over on the sidelines. That gave him two extra sets of eyes, so he could talk with them after a series. I think that helped keep Chase at ease and calm, and reassured him about the type of coverages he was seeing on the field."

## OBERLIN PREVIEW

The Yeomen broke into the win column last week with a 19-13 victory at Earlham. Freshman quarterback **David Kalgren (5-11/180/Curwensville, PA/Curwensville)** is coming off a season-best performance, throwing for 142 yards and one touchdown. Kalgren was 19-of-33 with one interception against Earlham, making him 55-of-108 through seven games. He's passed for 455 yards and three TDs.

**Ryan Harvey (JR/WR/5-10/180/Perry, OH/Perry)** is the top receiver for the Yeomen with 30 catches for 271 yards and one score. **CJ Holman (SO/WR/6-2/195/Arcadia, OH/Arcadia)** has 10 catches for 90 yards and a touchdown. **Sean Curtis (SO/RB/5-11/190/Cooper City, FL/Cooper City)** tops the Oberlin rushing list with 366 yards on 108 carries with two TDs. Kalgren is the second-leading rusher for the Yeomen with 281 yards and two scores in 72 attempts.

Freshman defensive back **Matt Misorski (5-11/200/Beaver, PA/Beaver Area)** earned the NCAC Defensive Player of the Week Award after recording a fumble recovery and an interception — his second of the season — in the second half to help the Yeomen hold on to its win over Earlham. He also recorded two tackles in the victory. **Tyler Lewis (JR/DB/6-3/195/Monroe, MI/Monroe)** is the leading tackler for Oberlin with 57 stops, including 28 solos. **Clay Eaton (FR/DL/6-1/225/Findley, OH/Van Buren)** has six tackles for losses totaling 16 yards and two sacks for three yards to lead Oberlin in both categories.

### LITTLE GIANTS BATTLE FOR FINAL SOCCER TOURNNEY SPOT

Wabash is in the hunt for one of four spots in the upcoming North Coast Athletic Conference Men's Soccer Tournament. The top four teams in the final conference standings, determined by total points, will begin play on November 4.

The Little Giants have never earned a berth in the conference tournament since joining the NCAC in 1999. Wabash is in sixth place heading into the final week of the regular season, one point out of fourth place. The Little Giants finish their regular season schedule on the road with a Wednesday match against Earlham, followed by a Saturday contest at Oberlin.

Two wins by the Little Giants, coupled with either a tie or a loss by Hiram in one of its final matches, would give the Little Giants sole possession of fourth place. Hiram plays at Denison Wednesday night before closing out the regular season Saturday at home against Wittenberg. Oberlin lost 2-0 at home to Kenyon Tuesday evening.

### RED PACK SET FOR NCAC CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

Wabash will travel to Delaware, Ohio Saturday to participate in the annual North Coast Athletic Conference Men's Cross Country Championship Race.

The Little Giants were picked to finish second by the cross country coaches at the beginning of the season after posting a third-place finish at the 2008 event. Wabash has finished no higher than third since joining the league in 1999, reaching that mark five times over a ten-year period.

Junior **Seth Einterz (Zionsville, IN/Zionsville)** finished fifth last season to earn First Team All-NCAC honors after finishing eighth as a freshman for Second Team All-NCAC honors. Sophomore **Kevin McCarthy (Zionsville, IN/Zionsville)** has posted the fast time of the season for the Little Giants on an 8,000-meter course. He crossed the finish line in 25:42 to win the Gibson Family Invitational in Terre Haute earlier this year.

## **TANKERS OPEN WITH RECORD-SETTING DAY AT NCAC RELAYS**

Wabash began the 2009-2010 swimming and diving season with a fifth place finish Saturday at the North Coast Athletic Conference Relays. The Little Giants posted eight top-10 finishes overall.

**Evan Rhinesmith (JR/McCordsville, IN/Mt. Vernon), David Birrer (JR/Indianapolis, IN/Brownsburg), Eric Vaughn (JR/Burlington, Ontario, Canada/Peters Township), and Craig Vetor (SR/Indianapolis, IN/Franklin Central)** scored a sixth place finish for Wabash with a time of 3:45.32 in the 400 individual medley relay. Rhinesmith's leadoff time of 55.9 broke the school record in the 100 IM, eclipsing the mark of 56.71 set by Joe Turk in 1989.

Divers **Korrey Short (FR/Bluffton, IN/Norwell)** and **Jake Schild (Indianapolis, IN/Lawrence Central)** earned third place finishes on the one- and three-meter boards. The duo combined for a score of 333.15 in one-meter competition, with Short scoring a 168.60 while Schild added a 164.55. The pair combined for a 338.60 in the three-meter event, with Short picking up a 183.80 while Schild finished with a 154.80.

The quartet of **Nick Rockefeller (SR/Topeka, KS/Washburn Rural), Chris Kermin (SO/LaPorte, IN/LaPorte), Vetor, and Alex Beck (FR/Richmond, IN/Richmond)** turned in the best group finish in the swimming events with a fourth in the 500-yard crescendo relay. The foursome posted a final time of 4:17.32.

Vaughn, **Robert Fozkos (SR/Valparaiso, IN/Chesterton), Adam Current (JR/Veedersburg, IN/Fountain Central),** and Birrer finished sixth in the 200 butterfly relay with a time of 1:37.22. Current, Rockefeller, **Steve Zajac (SR/Knoxville, TN/Lake Central),** and Vaughn took seventh in the 200 backstroke relay with a time of 1:41.26. Rhinesmith, Vaughn, Paul Buescher, and Vetor were ninth in the 200 breaststroke relay.

The trio of Vetor, Logan Rice, and Beck were tenth in the 1500 freestyle relay (15:23.72), while teammates Birrer, Logan Falley, and Chad Woods were a fraction behind in 11th place (15:23.76).

Wabash scored a total of 100 points. Denison won the men's competition with 176 points, followed by Kenyon (148), Wooster (106), and Wittenberg (102). Allegheny (88) was sixth, with Oberlin (52), Ohio Wesleyan (42), and Hiram (32) completing the team scoring.

**Next Meets:** The Little Giants return to action Friday evening with a dual meet in South Bend, Indiana. Wabash will compete against the Kalamazoo College men's team at 7 p.m. Saturday, the Little Giants will compete against Illinois Wesleyan and Rose-Hulman in a double-dual meet in Bloomington, Illinois at 1 p.m.
