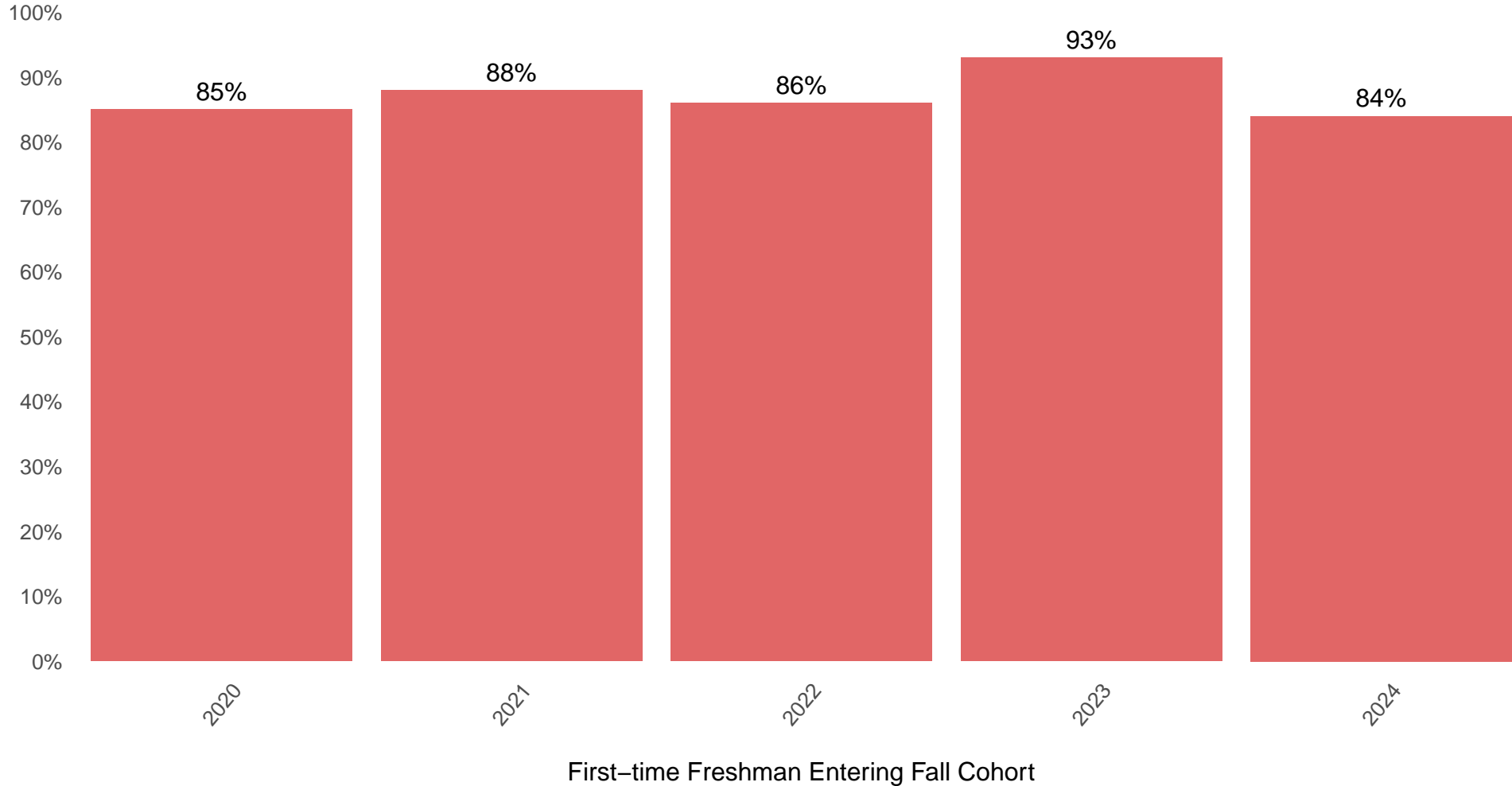

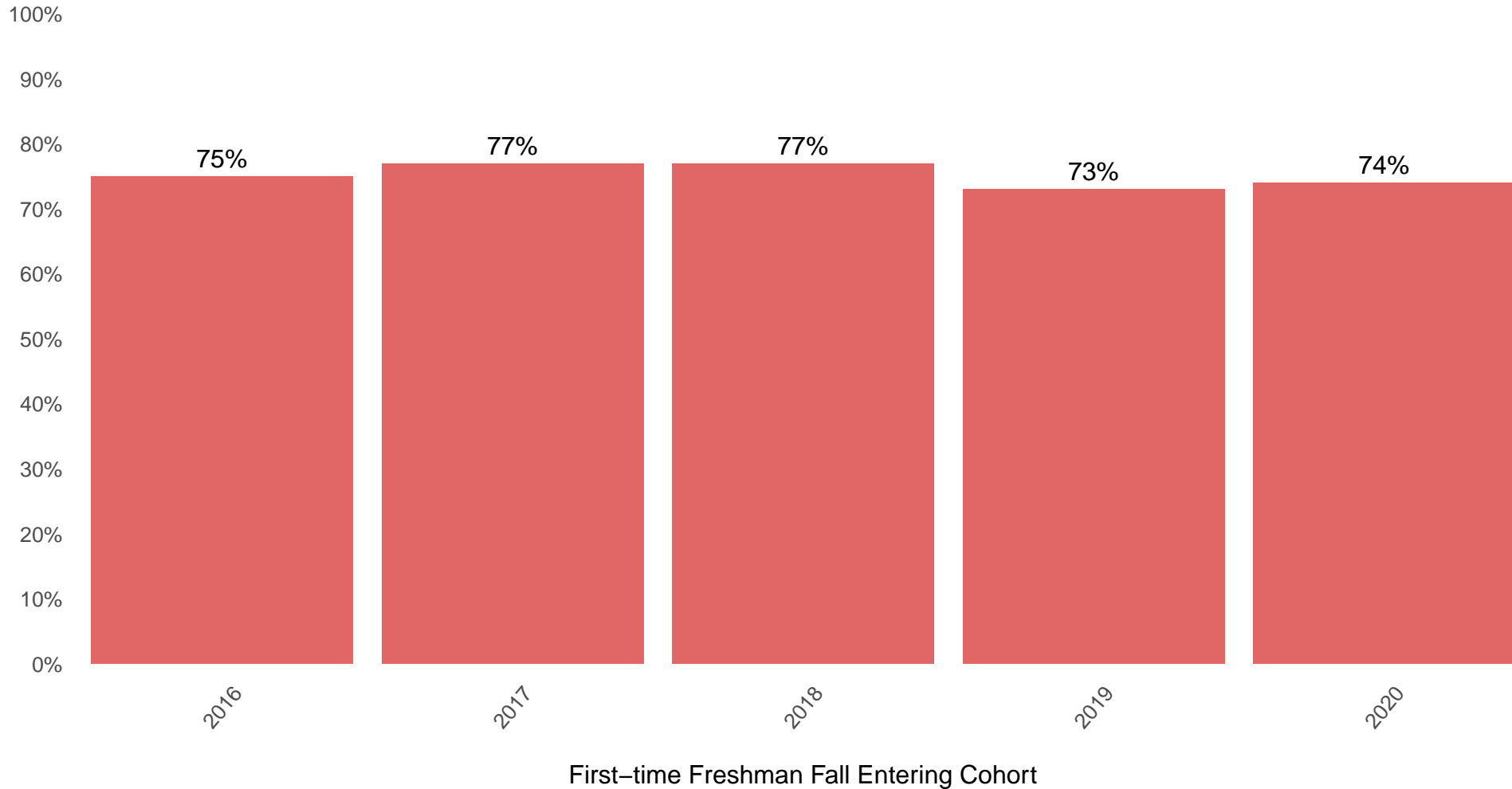

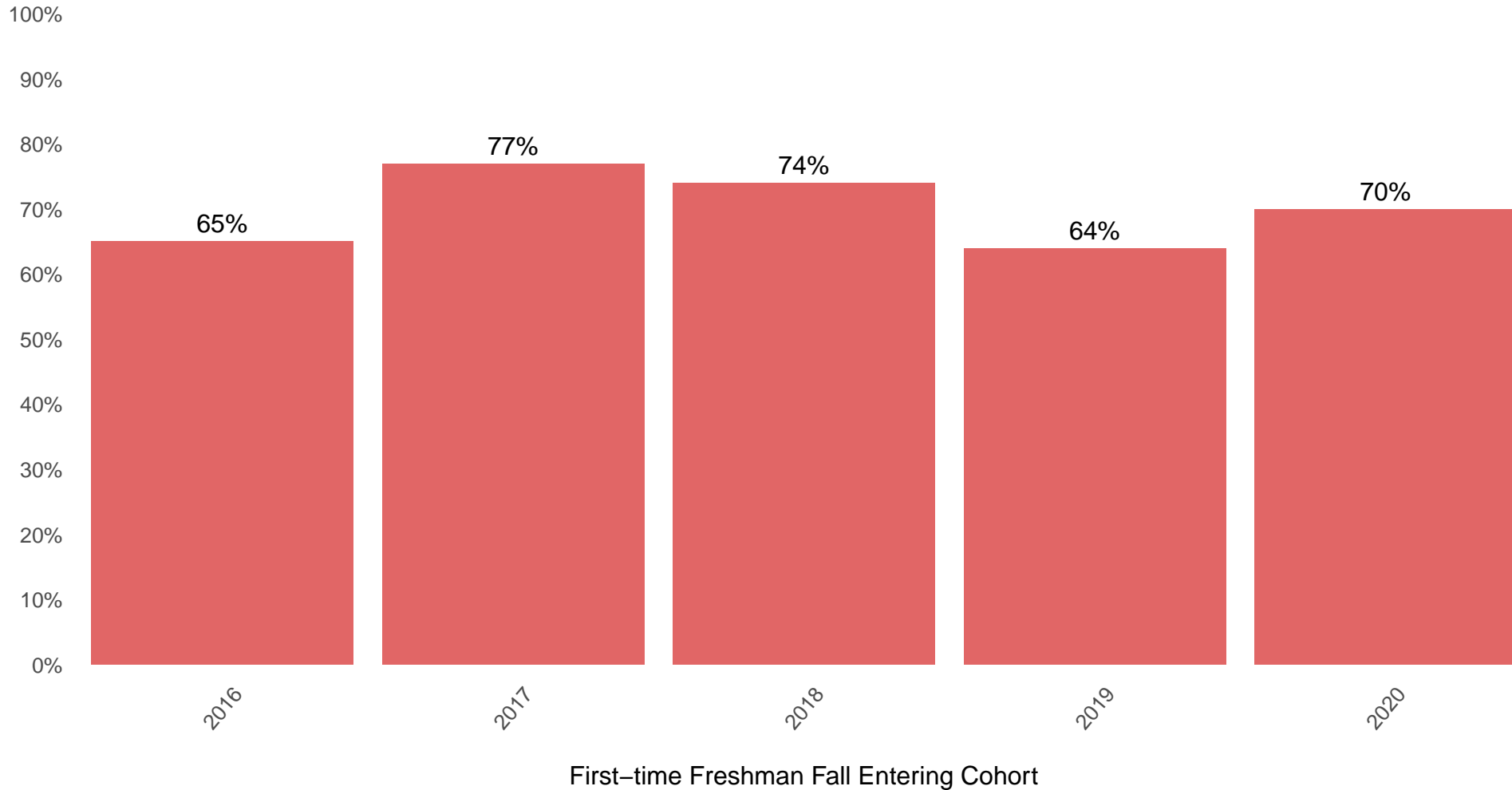

Pell grant recipients

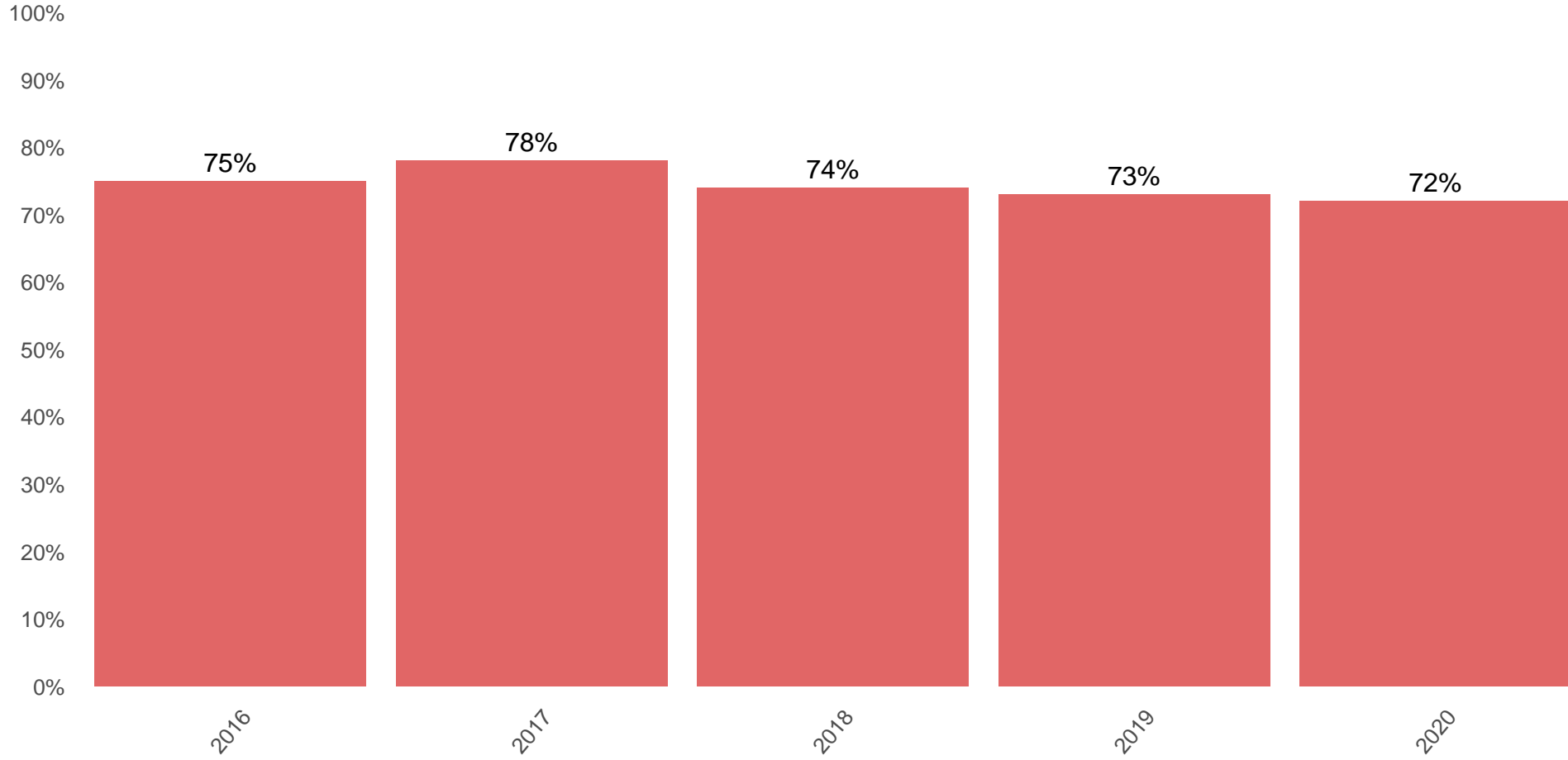

Stafford loan recipients that were not Pell recipients



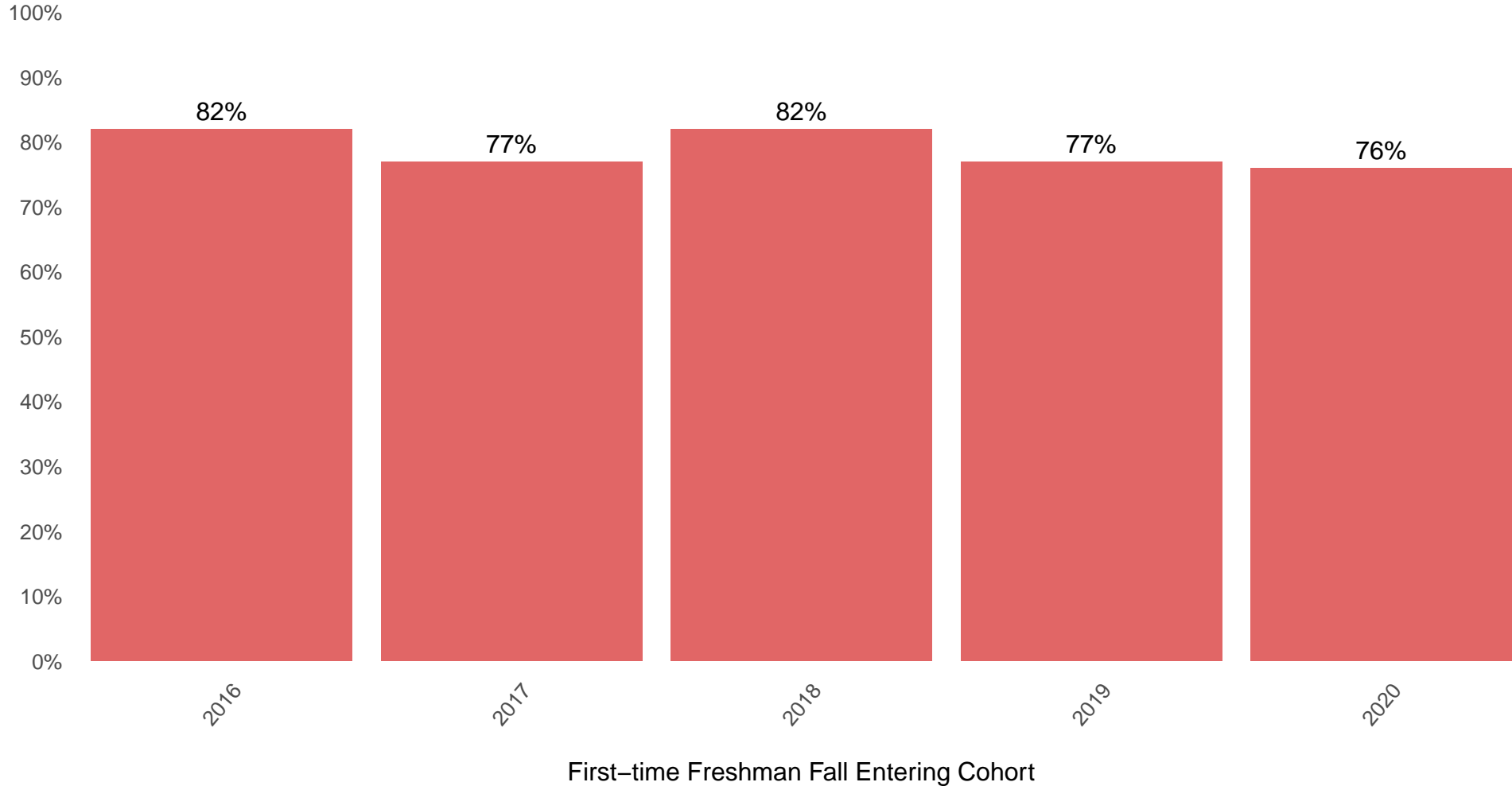

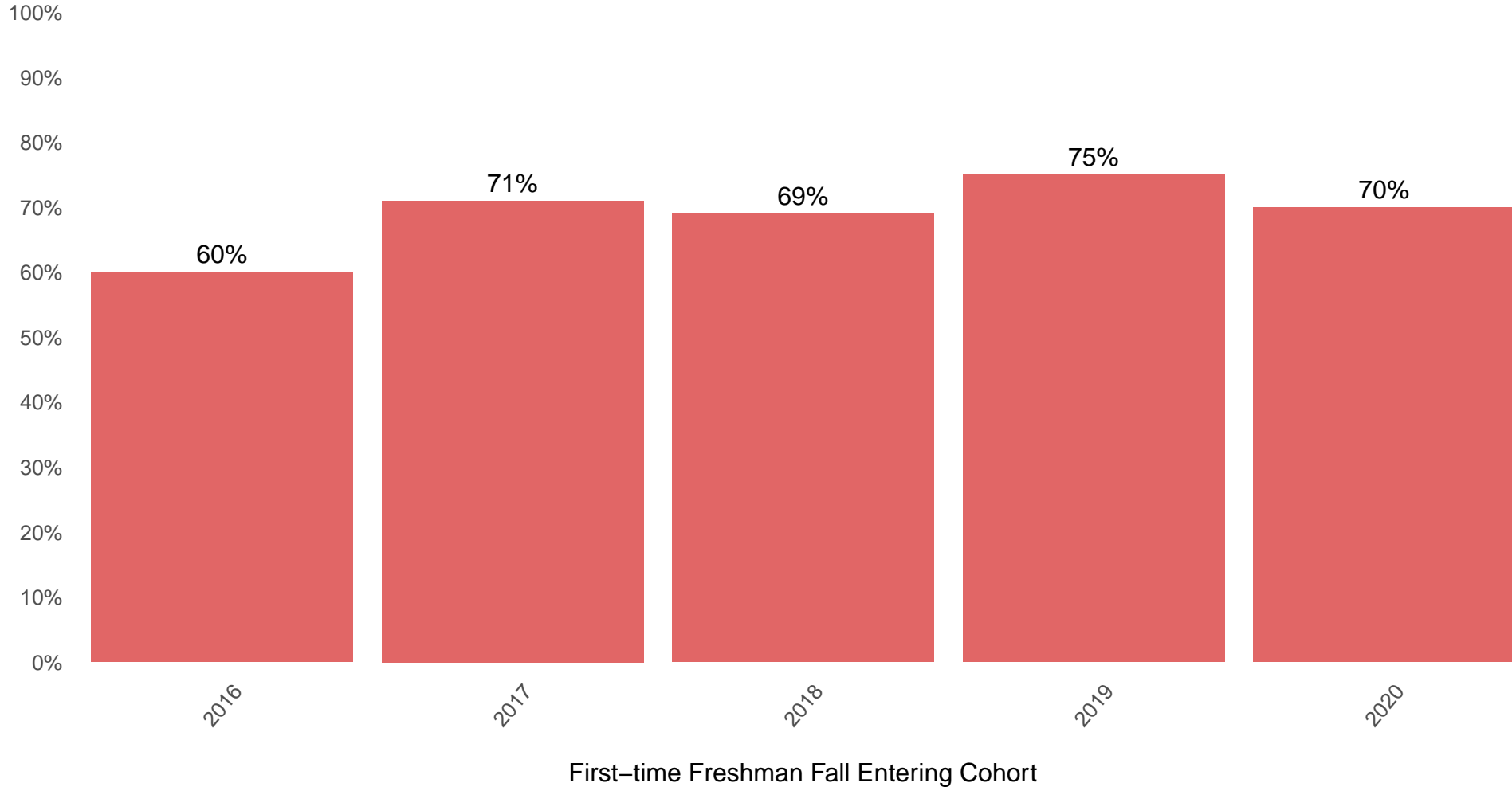

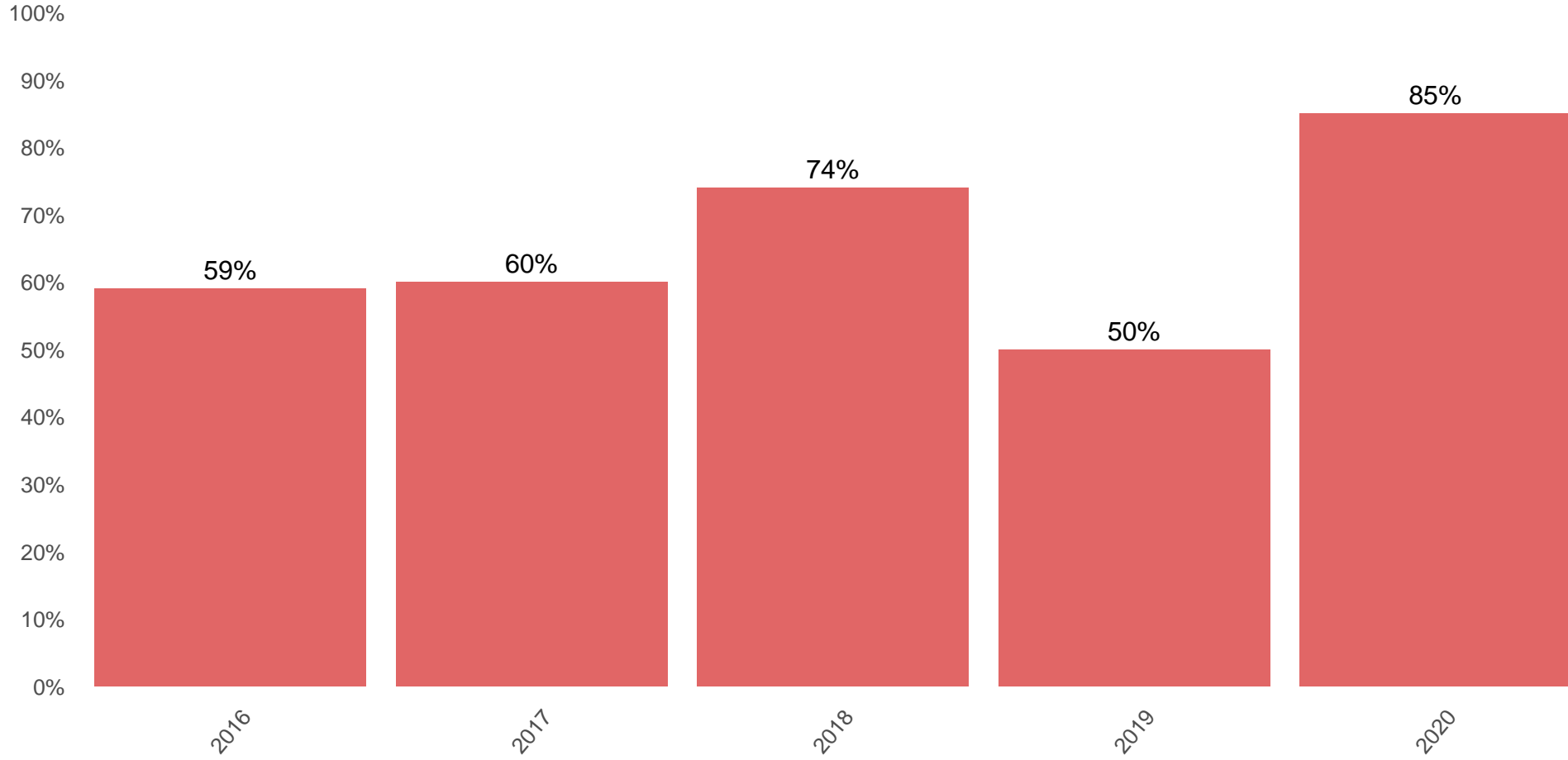
Wabash College 6–YR Grad Rate Black Students

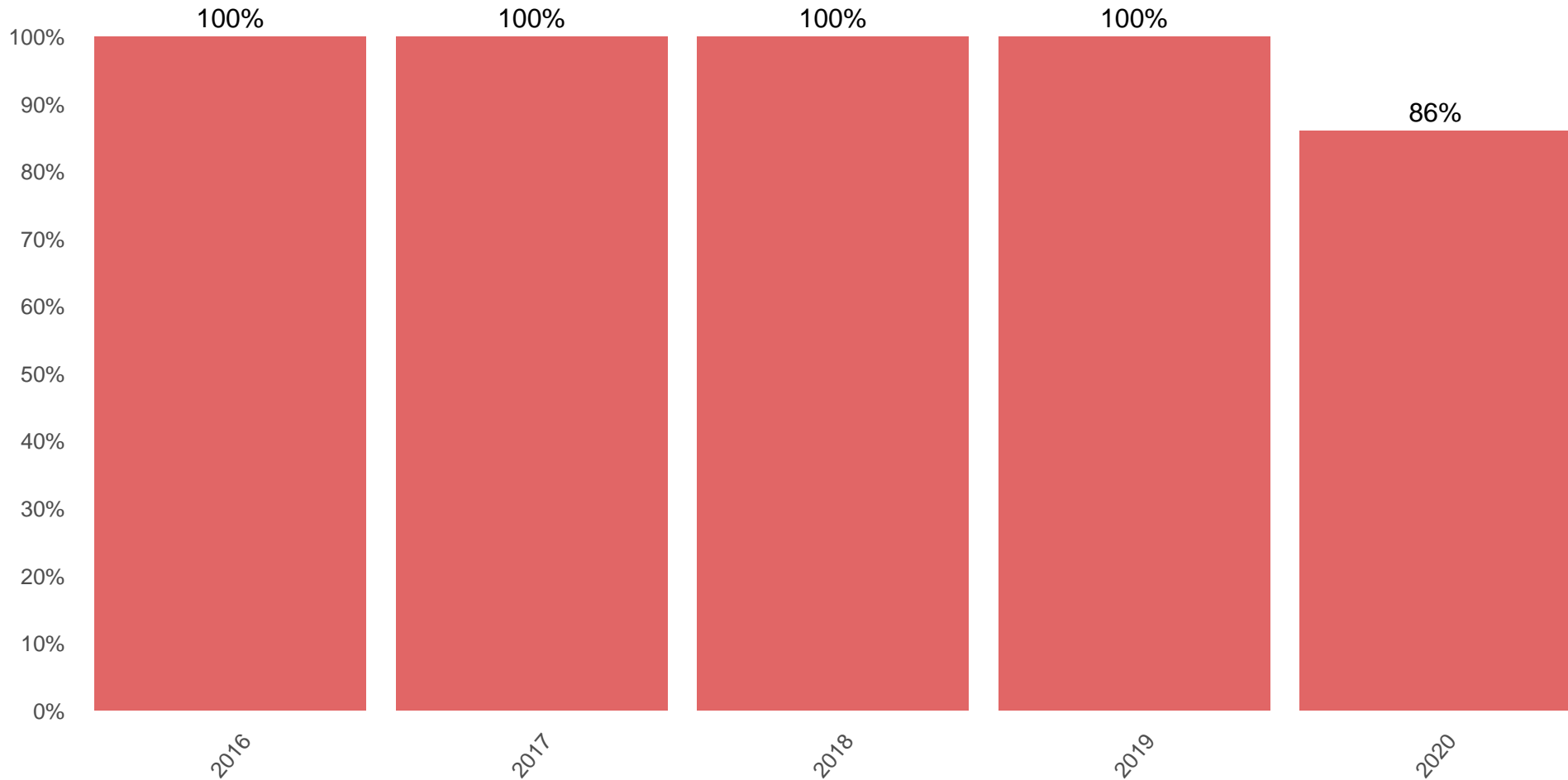

Wabash College 6–YR Grad Rate Asian Students

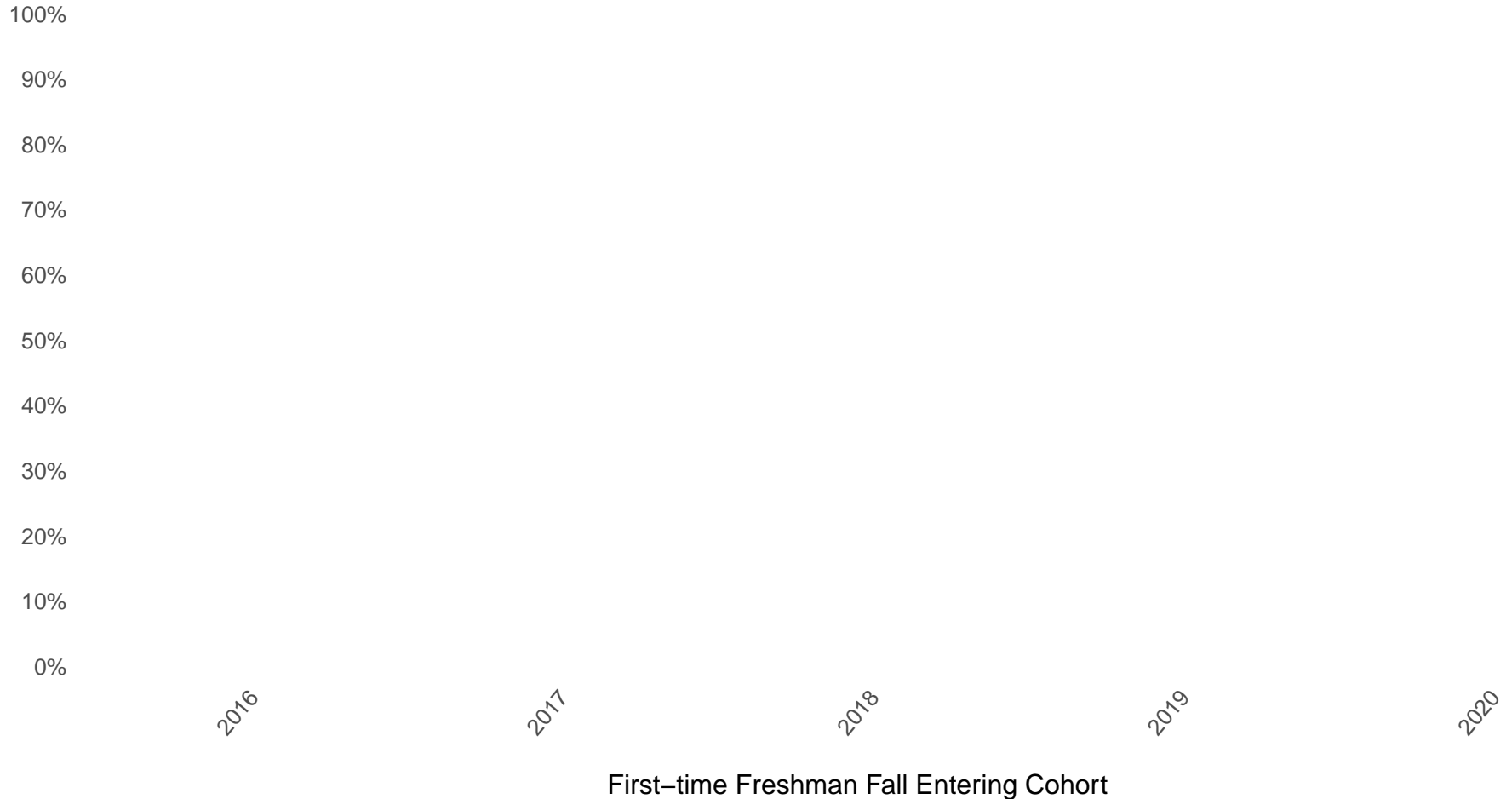

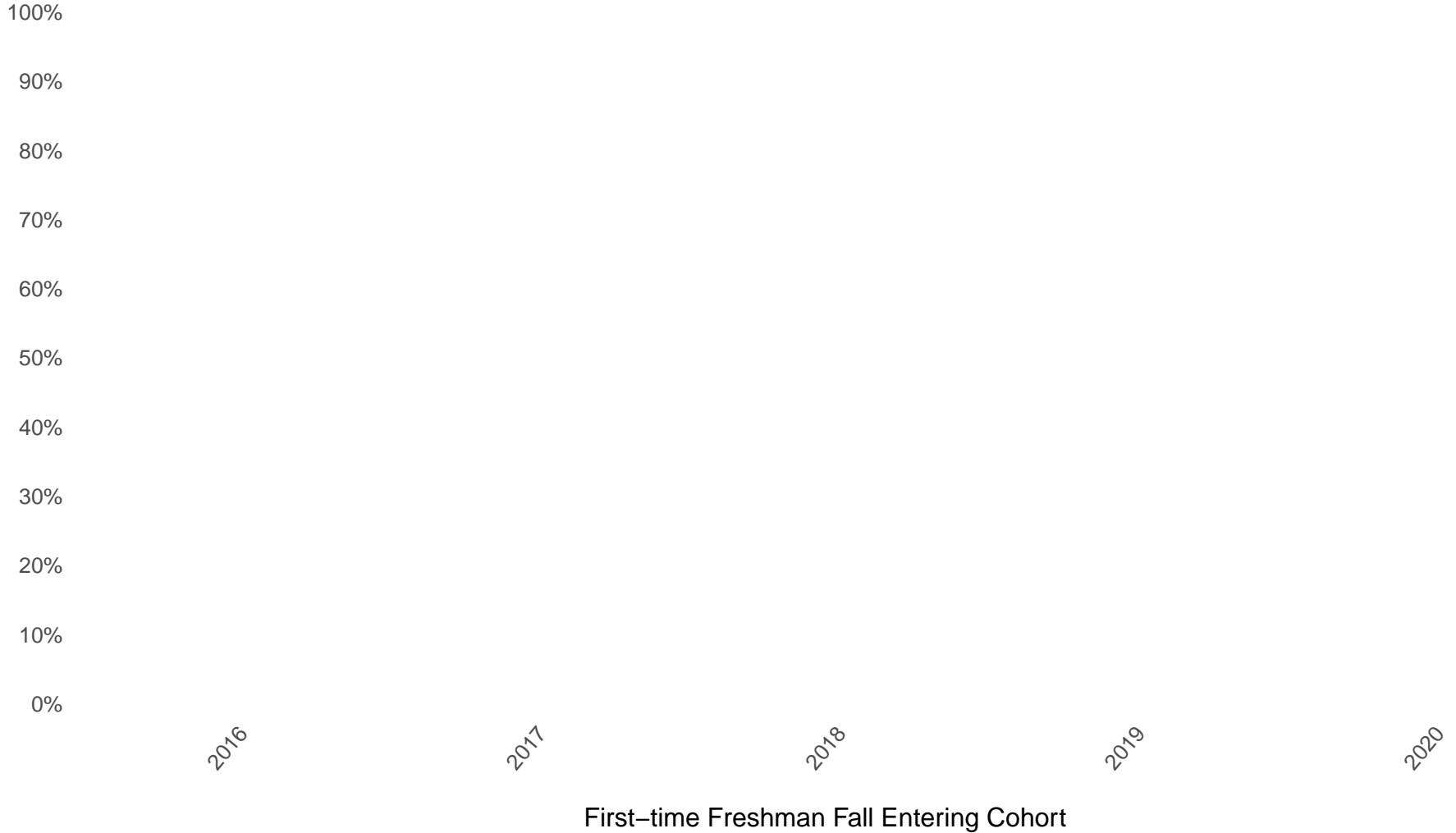

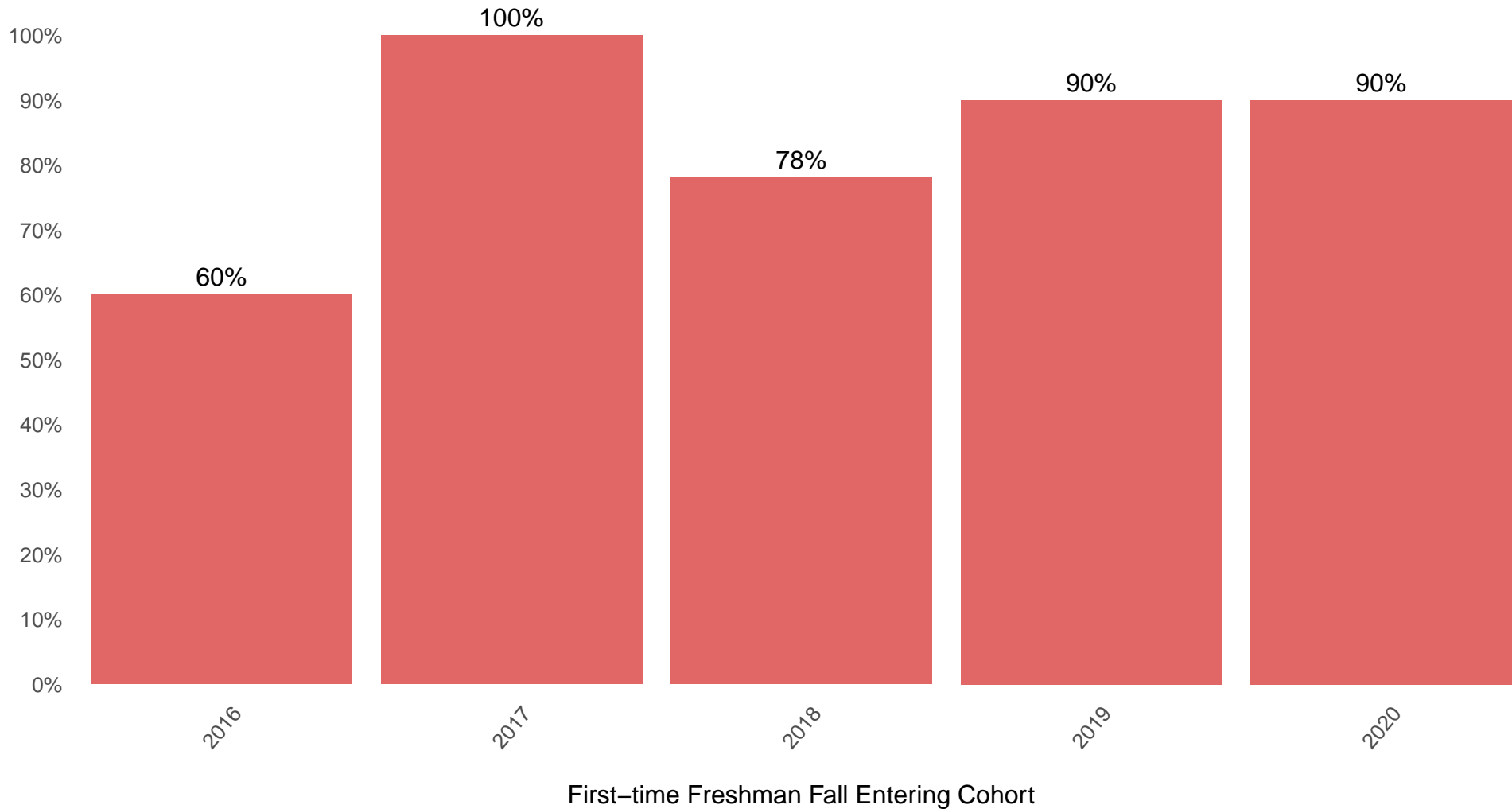

Students of 2 or More Races

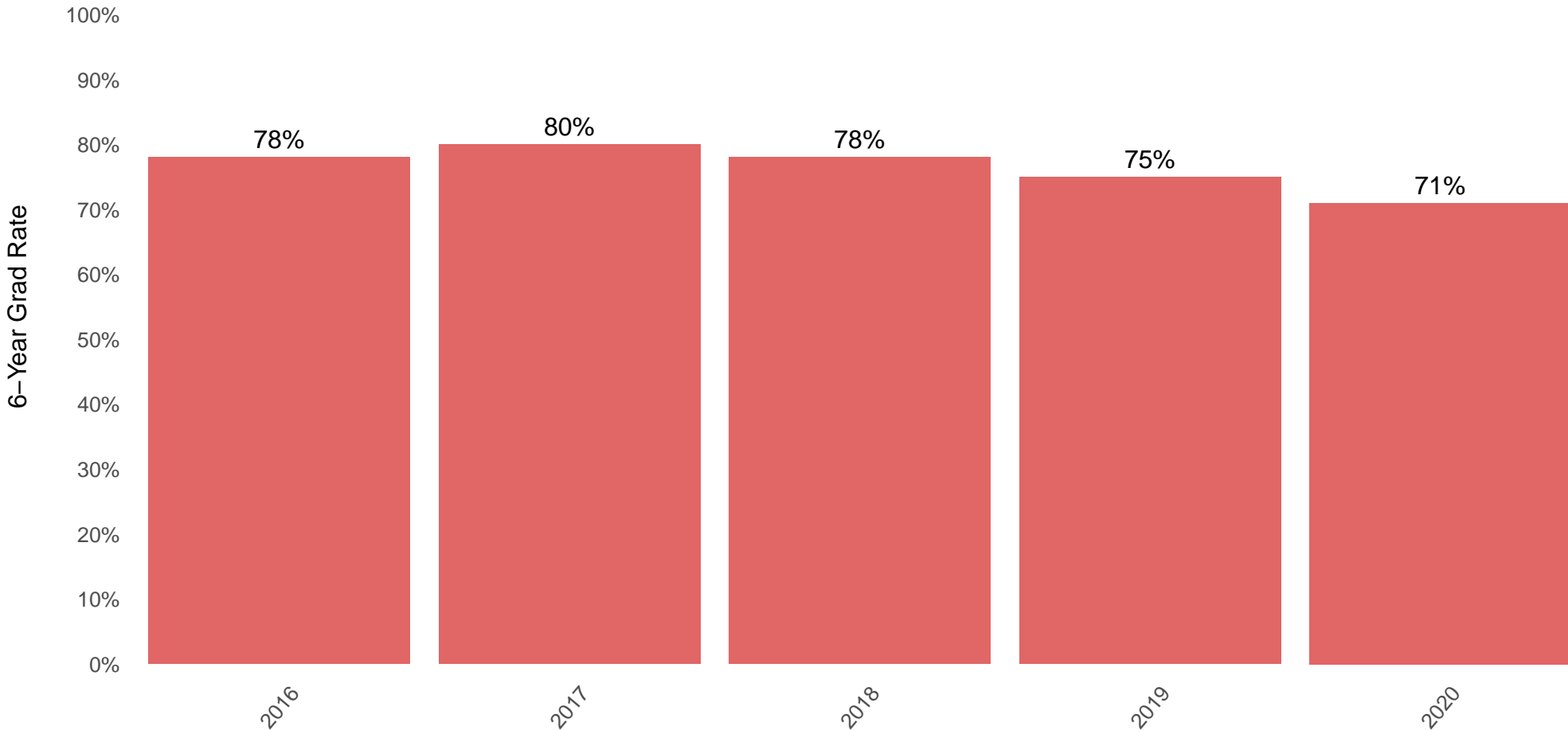

White Students

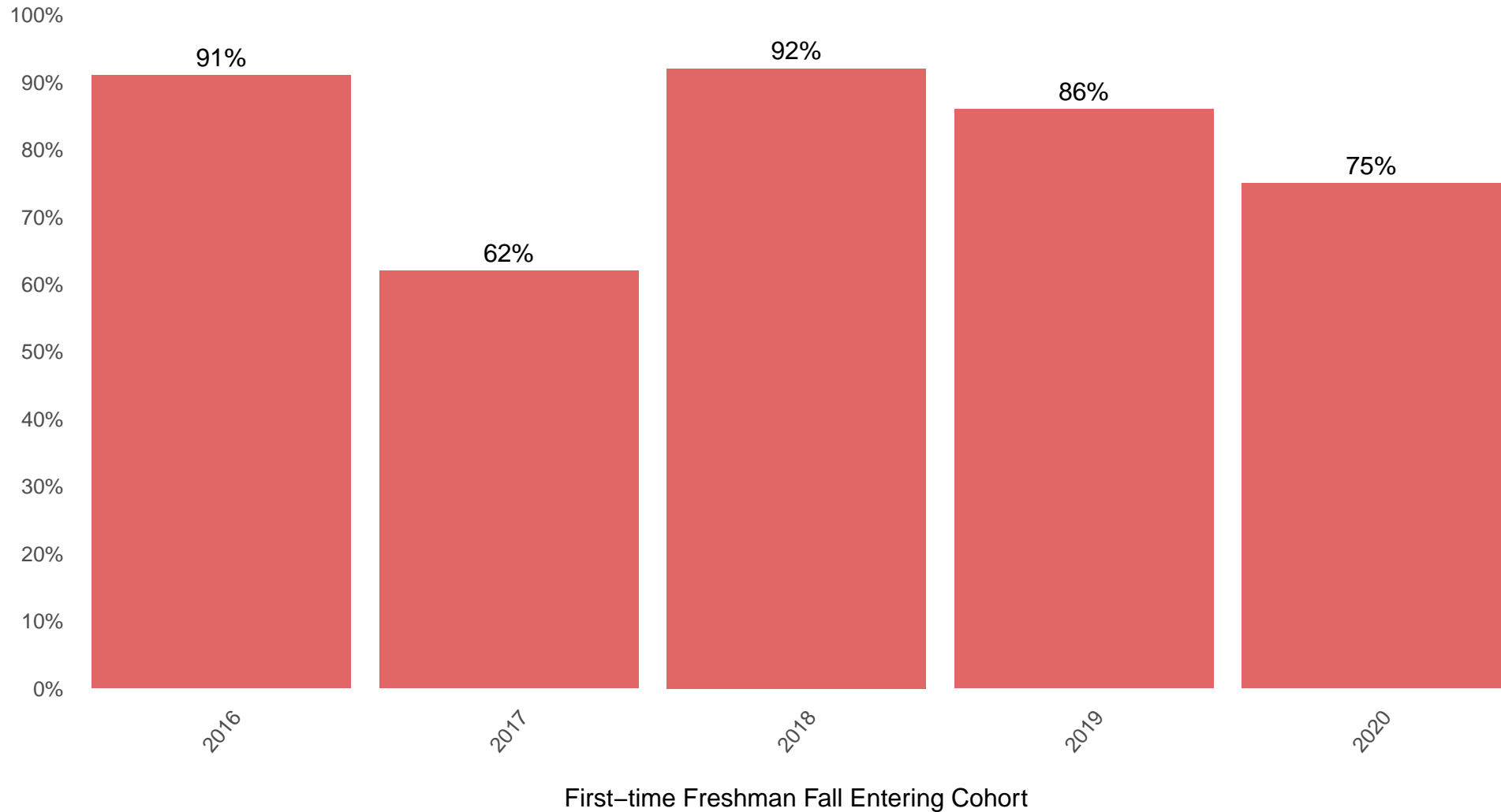

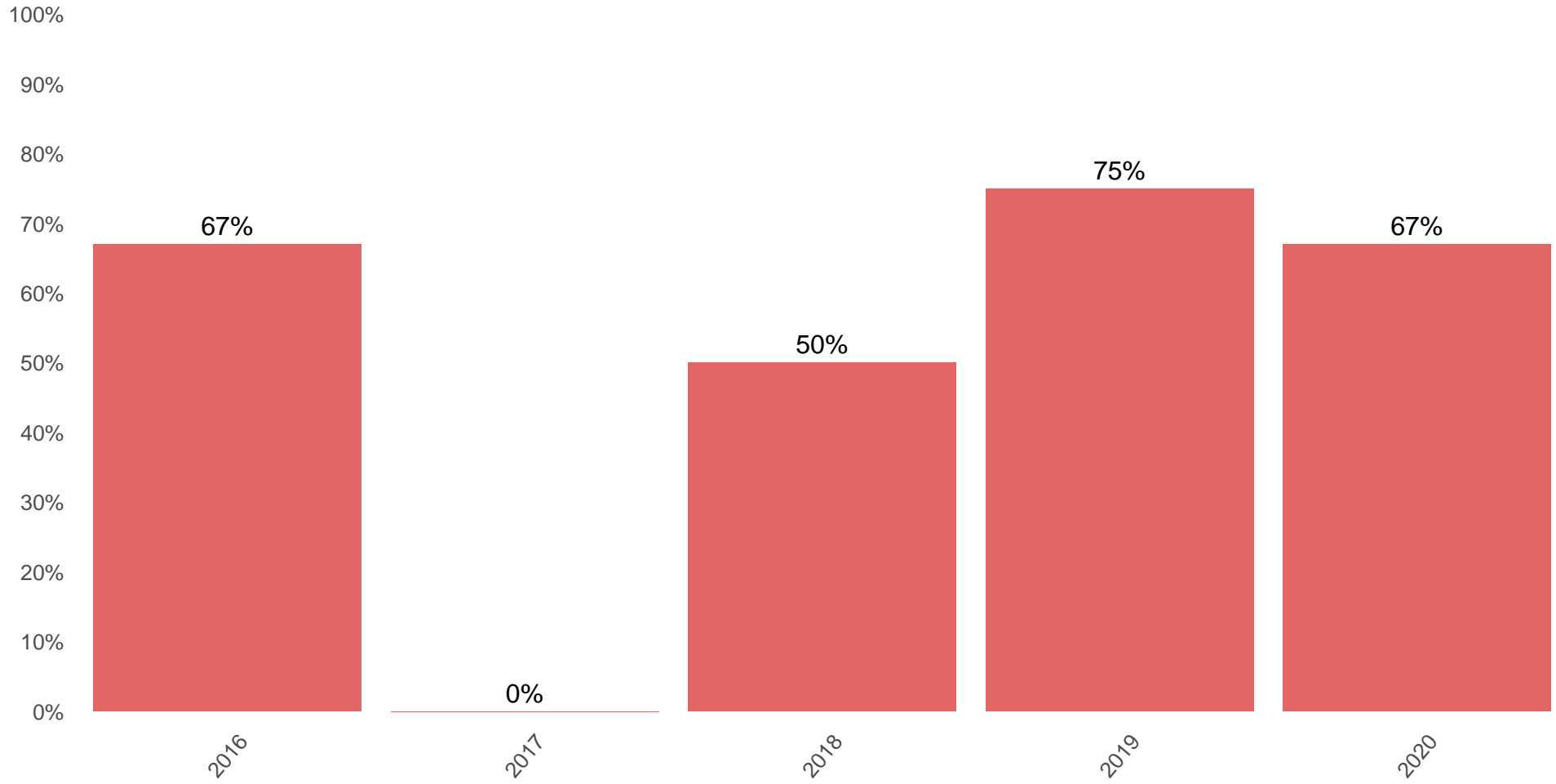
