

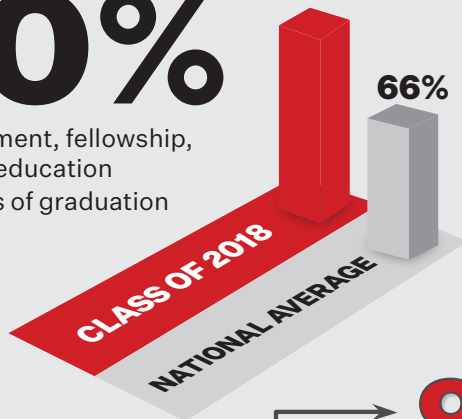

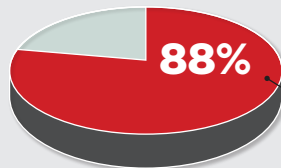

(87% of our seniors had secured employment, fellowship, or postgraduate education before graduation. 100% by six months. The national average is 64% six months after graduation.)

Whatever your major it will be among the top-ranked programs in the nation. (All 40 Wabash degree programs rank in the top 17 percent of the nation's nearly 1,400 four-year colleges with several of our programs ranking in the top 1 percent.)
