Early Decision Scholarship

\$2,000 Honors Scholarship Apply for admission and register for Scarlet Honors Weekend by December 1, 2025. Must attend Attend Scarlet Honors Weekend, December 6-7, 2025 OR February 15-16, 2026.

Wabash College Lilly Award

Complete application for admission and submit the Lilly Award application by January 4, 2026. Based on character, creativity, and academic accomplishment. Finalists interview February 22–23, 2026.

\*File Your FAFSA Award

Complete application for admission and file a FAFSA each year to maintain this award. Must be admitted to the College. No additional selection criteria.

\$1,000
\*Campus Visit Scholarship

Complete application for admission and attend any campus visit, except Scarlet Honors Weekend. Must be admitted to the College. No additional selection criteria.
