NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID FOR INDIANA STUDENTS

- Academically qualified Federal Pell Grant recipients from Indiana will receive grants to cover the balance of all tuition and fees not covered by government grants.
- Academically qualified students from families residing in Indiana with adjusted gross incomes up to \$125,000 will receive grants to lower the Wabash tuition and fees equivalent to tuition and fees at the state's flagship university.
- Students must have an unweighted GPA of 3.25 to qualify for these programs.
