

International Scholarships and Aid

- Trustee International Scholarship: a merit-based scholarship award covering total direct cost of four-year attendance, including tuition, fees, and on-campus room and board.
- Presidential International Scholarship: Merit-based scholarships ranging from \$30,000-\$40,000.
- On-Campus Employment: earn up to \$4,500 over the course of the academic year working 10-16 hours per week.
- Earn More Scholarship: admitted international students can earn an additional \$2,000 scholarship by attending two virtual events conducted by the international admissions team.
