\$2,000

Early Decision Scholarship

Apply Early Decision by November 15, 2026. Eligibility is based on a holistic review of your academics, including grades, course rigor, test scores (if submitted), and class rank (if available).

\$3,000

Honors Scholarship

Apply for admission and register for Scarlet Honors Weekend by December 1, 2026. Must attend Attend Scarlet Honors Weekend, December 4-5, 2026 OR February 2027.

Wabash College Lilly Award

Complete application for admission and submit the Lilly Award application by January 3, 2027. Based on character, creativity, and academic accomplishment. Finalists interview February 21-22, 2027.

***File Your FAFSA Award**

Complete application for admission and file a FAFSA each year to maintain this award. Must be admitted to the College. No additional selection criteria.

\$10,000

Snodell Scholarship

In addition to Merit Scholarships for student and families from Chicago, northern Illinois, southern Wisconsin and eastern Iowa.

Scholarships are available for four years. Amounts do not increase each year.

THE WABASH COLLEGE PROMISE

FOR NON-INDIANA RESIDENTS

- Academically qualified Pell Grant recipients that are non-Indiana residents with an SAI that does not exceed \$7,000 will receive grants to cover the balance of tuition and fees, plus an additional \$5,000 towards on-campus housing and food costs.

WABASH COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID PROCESS CHECKLIST

STEP 1

WHAT: Create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID - parent and student

WHY: FSA IDs are used to electronically sign the FAFSA

WHERE: Apply at <https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account>

WHEN: Due as soon as possible and is necessary to submit the FAFSA

STEP 2

WHAT: Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

WHY: To apply for eligible federal, state, and Wabash need-based financial assistance (including Federal Direct Student and Parent PLUS loans)

WHERE: Complete at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>

WHEN: Available October 1, 2026 – Please submit by February 1, 2027 for Wabash processing.
