\*For the 2020-2021 enrollment cycle, Wabash College will practice test-optional admission. Applicants are not required to submit standardized test scores as part of their application for admission.

Students who choose not to submit standardized test scores will still be considered for merit-based scholarships. This review will place additional weight on the rigor of the applicant's high school curriculum as well as his performance in his college preparatory courses.

All standardized test score submissions will be super scored.

<b>Wabash College Lilly Awards</b> <b>Tuition, fees, on-campus room and board each year.</b> More than \$200,000 over four years.	Complete application for admission and submit the Lilly Award application by January 5, 2021.	Based on character, creativity, and academic accomplishment. Finalists interviewed February 21–22, 2021.
<b>Snodell Scholarships</b> <b>Up to \$15,000 each year for four years.</b>	Complete application for admission by January 15, 2021.	Based on residence in Chicago, northern Illinois, southern Wisconsin, and eastern Iowa.

- Students selected as Lilly Award recipients are not eligible for additional Wabash Merit-Based Scholarships/Awards.
- Wabash College is a Division III member of the NCAA. Consequently, we cannot consider athletic participation, ability, or leadership roles in the awarding of Wabash scholarships.
- Recommended Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) filing date is January 15, 2021.
- Complete application for admission by March 1, 2021.

# WABASH COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID PROCESS CHECKLIST

## STEP 1

- WHAT:** **Create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID** (one for the student, one for the parent)  
**WHY:** FSA IDs are used to electronically sign the FAFSA  
**WHERE:** Apply at [www.fsaaid.ed.gov](http://www.fsaaid.ed.gov)  
**WHEN:** Due as soon as possible and is necessary to submit the FAFSA

## STEP 2

- WHAT:** **Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**  
**WHY:** To apply for eligible need-based financial assistance at the federal and state levels (including Federal Direct Student and Parent PLUS loans)  
**WHERE:** Complete at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/>  
**WHEN:** Available October 1, 2020 – **We recommend that students file as soon as possible. Please submit by January 15, 2021 for Wabash processing.**
