ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS	HOW TO APPLY	SELECTION CRITERIA
Wabash College Lilly Awards Tuition, fees, on-campus room and board each year. More than \$200,000 over four years.	Complete application for admission and submit the Lilly Award application by November 1, 2017.	Based on character, creativity, and academic accomplishment. Finalists interviewed on campus November 30 and December 1, 2017.
Honor Scholarships Up to \$165,000 over four years; Up to full tuition per year.	Apply for admission by December 1, 2017 and attend Scarlet Honors Weekend December 1-2, 2017.	Students must have a completed application by December 8, 2017. Must attend Scarlet Honors Weekend December 1-2, 2017.
Fine Arts Scholarships Up to \$60,000 over four years; Up to \$15,000 per year.	Complete application for admission and submit the Fine Arts Scholarship application by December 1, 2017.	Excellence in the fine arts; creative writing, music, theater, art, film and digital media. Applicants will audition/display work on campus via a personal visit prior to December 1 or during Scarlet Honors Weekend December 1-2, 2017.
Snodell Scholarships Up to \$15,000 each year for four years.	Complete application for admission by January 15, 2018.	Based on residence in Chicago, northern Illinois, southern Wisconsin, and eastern Iowa.

- Students selected as Lilly Award recipients or who receive the largest Honor Scholarship are not eligible for additional Wabash Merit-Based Scholarships/Awards. Students selected to receive more than one of the other Wabash Merit-Based Scholarships/Awards will receive the monetary value of their highest award plus a maximum of an additional \$1,000 to represent each Wabash Merit-Based Scholarship/Award of an equal or lesser monetary value.
- Wabash College is a member of the NCAA Division III. Consequently, we cannot consider athletic participation, ability, or leadership roles in the awarding of Wabash scholarships.
- Recommended Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) filing date is January 15, 2018.
- Complete application for admission by March 1, 2018.

WABASH COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID PROCESS CHECKLIST

STEP 1

- WHAT:** **Create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID** (one for the student, one for the parent)
WHY: FSA IDs are used to electronically sign the FAFSA
WHERE: Apply at www.fsaaid.ed.gov
WHEN: Due as soon as possible but will be necessary to submit the FAFSA

STEP 2

- WHAT:** **Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**
WHY: To apply for eligible need-based financial assistance at the federal and state levels (including Stafford and parent PLUS loans)
WHERE: Complete at www.fafsa.gov
WHEN: Available October 1, 2017 – **We recommend that students file as soon as possible. Please submit by January 15, 2018 for Wabash processing**

STEP 3

- WHAT:** **Complete Verification**
WHY: If a student has been selected for verification, he will be required to submit information to the Financial Aid Office. He will be notified by the Financial Aid Office as to what items will be required. A financial aid package is not prepared until all required verification materials have been submitted.
WHERE: Complete the verification process at financialaid@wabash.edu
WHEN: Due two weeks after receiving notification from financial aid
