Dear Colleagues,

As a reminder, we are in the process of phasing in new requirements for Political Science majors. Here's the pertinent advising info:

Current seniors and juniors majoring in Political Science should complete the old major requirements, which are listed in the archived Academic Bulletin from 2017-18: http://bulletin.wabash.edu/archive/2017-18_Academic_Bulletin.pdf. Current juniors do not need to complete the ECO 101 and HIS 102 collateral requirements.

Sophomores and freshmen intending to major in Political Science should complete the new major requirements, as described in the current edition of the Academic Bulletin, here: <http://bulletin.wabash.edu/programsaz/political-science/#requirementstext>. Ideally, they should complete the first three requirements (PSC 131; PSC 111, 121, **or** 141; and PSC 200) by the end of their sophomore year.

PSC 200: Political Inquiry & Analysis, should be taken by sophomores and juniors majoring in Political Science only; it is not intended for non-Political Science majors seeking behavioral science distribution credit. Students who would like to take this course should email me for permission. We do have a number of other 200-level course offerings that are open to students from all majors.
