Wabash held a Day of Giving on April 29, 2026. The College reported:

This April, 3,848 donors from Wabash Nation gave 9,444 gifts to the College on a single day, totaling \$2,160,915. All three of those numbers are new Wabash College Day of Giving records, and we're grateful to all of you for giving, calling your friends, sharing posts online, and spreading the word.

The Class of 1995 challenge raised \$16,127 from 146 gifts by 51 unique donors. Way to go guys!
