Wabash Brothers,

It's been nearly 400 days since we joined together for the last time as the Class of 2025 for commencement in Little Giant Stadium, and whether you've started your career, are pursuing further education, or are still figuring out your path, we all have a lot to be proud of as a class. The lives we have begun to build for ourselves will forever be shaped by our Wabash educations, and the legacy we left behind on campus with friends, roommates, and fraternity brothers in lower classes remains alive and well. The class of 2026 celebrated 217 graduates with a four-year graduation rate of 77.9%, which is the third highest ever and it was even higher for first-generation college students. The First Destination Rate for the Class of 2026 at graduation was 73%, up 11 percentage points over our class. If you haven't yet taken some time to congratulate your brothers who graduated last month, they'd certainly appreciate a quick text or call to catch up, or get some early career advice from a friend.

The Day of Giving on April 29 was a resounding success with 3,848 **donors** giving **9,444 gifts** to the College totaling **\$2,160,915**. All three of those numbers are new Wabash College Day of Giving records. On top of that, it was a historic day for young alumni ('20-'25), nearly doubling last year's donor count. The Class of 2025 had the **second highest** number of donors on the day



(behind Wabash's largest class from '91) with **81**. Thanks to everyone who gave, shared, and spread the word!

In the spirit of those record breaking successes, Wabash takes enormous pride in having a 40% alumni giving percentage because it matters to large donors when deciding where to invest, it influences how faculty see Wabash when looking for jobs, and because it signals to prospective students the strength of the Wabash community not just for four years, but for a lifetime.

At our age, Wabash doesn't expect much. All they need is a small showcase of support for Wabash that they can spin to show to those with millions, to new faculty, and new students just how much Wabash Alumni care about our Alma Mater. Being a donor matters more than the donation amount. There's a \$5 minimum to donate online at [wabash.edu/give](http://wabash.edu/give), but there's no minimum donation through Venmo (@wabashcollege) or mail. \$1 is enough to get yourself counted for the fiscal year's donor data.

Also, some of you may have already donated if you have a Wabash license plate. Having a Wabash plate makes a \$25 annual donation to the College paid through your registration fees. If you have a Wabash plate and haven't already received a thank you letter from Wabash this year, email [alumni@wabash.edu](mailto:alumni@wabash.edu) and they'll get you counted properly.

We've already broken records with Class of 2025's Day of Giving participation, and I'm sure we can continue doing so by the time FY2025 closes out on the 30th!
