Another year rolls around for the Ringing In of the Freshman class by President Hess using the historic Caleb Mills Bell. (This brings back memories for all of us!). This year the Freshman class consists of 235 students. The class has students from eight countries, 48 legacies, five valedictorians, 16 earned perfect scores on a section of ACT or SAT, six Eagle Scouts, a member of a national Rugby team, and a two-time cancer survivor.

The Forbes List recently rated Wabash Alumni among the best in the country. We were rated tenth nationally on the list of most engaged donors in private non-profit institutions with enrollment more than 500. Wabash and Notre Dame were the only Indiana institutions in the Top Ten.

We can still be proud of our million dollar contribution in 2003. Our class plaque located on the east side of the Hays Science Center is a permanent reminder of our class gift.

The 2020 edition of the Fiske Guide to Colleges listed Wabash as one of the top colleges in the US, Canada and UK.

Wabash placed 47 students on the North Coast Athletic Conference Academic Honor Roll.

One of the newest campus projects is the Gateway entrance. The College has purchased several properties on the northeast and south corners of Wabash Ave. and Grant Ave. The entrance will give visitors a clearer sense of arrival on campus and is designed to improve foot traffic pathways on campus.
