Our class continued to do well and outshine most classes in our Annual Giving for last fiscal Year ('17). The total Annual Fund finished the year at \$3.274 million --an increase of nearly \$150,000 vs. previous year. Total Alumni Participation rate was 43.9%. **Class of '72** contributed **\$206,167**, with a participation rate of

39.7%. Our participation was up from the previous year, but not as high as 3 years ago when almost 43% of us participated. Still, a very good performance on our part. Thanks to all of you who gave!!!
