Wabash Soccer had a good year finishing 11-6-2. Soccer made it to the final four of the NCAC but lost badly in the semi final..Two new opponents for the Soccer Boys are/were Grinnell and the University of Chicago. Soccer beat DPU 2-1 at the end of the season. Two Players were honored at year's end:

- Junior Coledon Johnson as a United Soccer Coaches Scholar All American and
- Cristian Aleman, a Senior, as a United Soccer Coaches Third Team All American. Aleman is the first Wabash soccer player to be named to an All-America team since Momodou Jagne in 1998..

Wabash Basketball is off to a good pre holiday start at 7-3. Led by Senior Jack Davidson and Junior Tyler Watson 2021-2022 should be a special year for Wabash.

One casualty of the Pandemic was our 45th College Reunion. Originally scheduled for June 2021 then pushed off to the fall of 2021 on a Football Weekend, we had sparse attendance of approximately 6 people instead of the usual 40-45. I suggest we accept that for exactly what it was....and work hard to get more significant attendance at our next and upcoming events.
