A quick note to ensure that you have seen the March 18th email from Steve Hoffman at the College detailing the College's decisions surrounding the Wabash Reunion Weekend of June 4-6, 2021.

In sum, the College is moving our 45<sup>th</sup> Reunion Celebration of the Great Class of 1976 to the fall, specifically a TailGate celebration on Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup> prior to the Football Game against Wooster.
