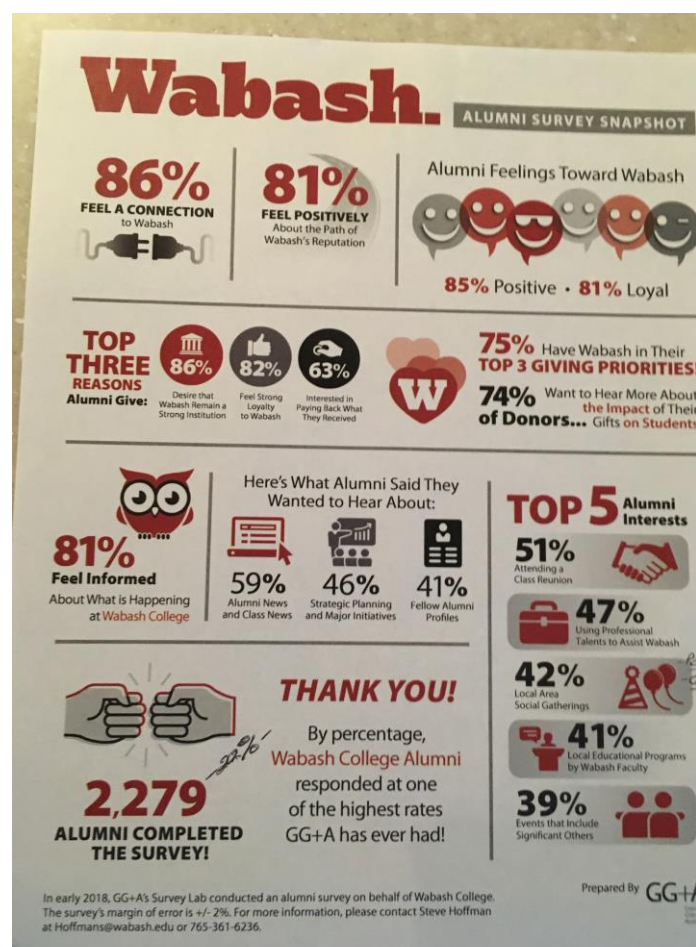

One of the highlights of the Class Agent's Forum, held earlier this month, were results of the college's 2018 Alumni Survey. Hope that you were one of the 2,279 alumni who completed this survey. At left you see a graphic with some of the survey's results. I won't summarize this sheet (you can read it), but a key takeaway is the excellent feelings our alumni have for their alma mater. One subject I will note: A good thing we say that we most want is alumni news, and news about their classmates. I'm doing the best I can, but I'm still in the work force and have a lot going on in my life. If you are recently retired and want to assist Herm, Greg and me with news about your classmates, we'd love to have more help.

**DAY OF GIVING** – We've shared some details of the April event with you. Our numbers are even more outstanding than what's already reported. Our 3,710 total donors made 5,175 gifts and pledged an average of \$1,236 per student that day, for a total amount of just over \$1 million to the college. This is BY FAR better than any other college or university doing a similar event.
