Ding! Ding! Ding! . . . That wonderful tone from the Monon Bell will fill the air on campus this Saturday as our beloved Little Giants host DePauw in the 125th renewal of the Monon Bell Classic. Kickoff is set for 1:07 p.m. EST on November 10.

If you're not one of the lucky ones to attend in person, the game will be telecast on Fox Sports Midwest, plus Fox Sports Indiana, and Fox College Sports. Or, there will also be a lot of Wabash-DePauw viewing parties throughout the country. Wabash enters the Bell game with an 8-1 record, coming off a 54-17 triumph over Allegheny on Saturday in Crawfordsville. The Little Giants' 28-21 upset (in overtime) at Wittenberg on October 27 lifted them to a tie in the North Coast Athletic Conference standings. Should Wabash dump the Dannies, the Little Giants will share the NCAC crown and will have to wait and see if they get into the Div. III playoffs.

A few facts about the 125th Monon Bell Game:

- Wabash and DePauw first met on the gridiron in 1890, making it the “longest continuous rivalry west of the Alleghenies.”
- Wabash leads the overall series 61-54-9, having won eight of the last nine meetings.
- Wabash also leads the series 42-38-6 since the Monon Bell was donated as the series trophy in 1932.
- Wabash is currently ranked 21st in the NCAA Division III poll.
- DePauw stands at 4-5 – a disappointing record as DPU was thought of as potential NCAC champs by some pre-season prognosticators.
