Class News & Wabash News:

- Chris Braun was elected to the Board of Trustees this spring. Congratulations, Chris! The Class of 1981 has two members on the Board: Chris and David Lewis.
- 198 men graduated in the Class of 2019 this May and two outstanding Honorary Degree recipients were awarded to Mauri A. Ditzler '75 and Robert H. Johnson H'77.
 - 87% of the Class of 2019 have already settled in to their first destination plans: jobs, graduate or professional schools, or service. Five members of the class received prestigious Fulbright Fellowships and another four earned Robert Orr Fellowships. Wabash has had 22 graduates receive Fulbright Fellowships since 2014.
- The sixth Annual Day of Giving took place on April 18th and produced 5,238 gifts and 3,805 unique donors and raised \$ 1.1 million raised in ***a single day***.
- The Giant Steps Campaign which went public on November 9, 2018, has raised \$161 million in gifts, pledges and bequests on the way to the goal of \$225. More than 25 regional events were held across the county in the past six months and more are planned for this summer and fall.
