In the fall of '66, about the time that many of us were born, Wabash College dedicated a new football stadium. Fifty-three years later that stadium has been deemed obsolete, and is being torn down. I hope you are doing better than that!

If you have not heard, on the strength of an anonymous ten-million-dollar donation, Little Giant stadium is being torn down this winter, to be replaced by a new Little Giant stadium which is scheduled to be ready for the start of play next fall.

This and many other exciting things are underway at our alma mater. In addition to the replacement of Little Giant stadium, plans are underway to renovate the Lilly Library, though the time-line for that project is (only) slightly longer than the replacement of the stadium.

Moving away from bricks and mortar, the college established two new majors this fall: Computer Science and Philosophy, Politics, and Economics (PPE). Similar to Little Giant stadium, the PPE major comes to us on the strength of a gift from Trustee, Tom Walsh. As of this writing the college's newest graduating class is 99.5% placed either in graduate school, professional school, military service, or their first job. On average schools shoot for 60% placement within six months of graduation, so I think we are doing all right.

It's been a mixed bag for our sports teams. The football team made the playoffs, but lost the bell to the cretins to the south. The soccer team (the other football) made the NCAC playoffs this fall, and Chris Kelleher was named the NCAC soccer coach of the year. The basketball team headed into play this year ranked #1 in pre-season NCAC polls.

As we head toward the end of the calendar year, if your giving to the college takes place on a calendar year basis, please be sure to make your gift.
