

Wabash College Guidance on Students Traveling Together in Cars

Students traveling together in personal or College-owned vehicles should abide by the following guidelines:

- 1. Masks must be worn by all vehicle occupants.
- 2. Windows must be down to provide maximum air flow.
- 3. Cars should be limited to a maximum of 50% of normal occupancy, e.g., two persons in most standard cars.
- 4. Seating should maximize the distance between passengers, e.g., diagonally with driver in front and passenger in the rear on the passenger side.
- 5. Limit trips to the shortest distance possible, especially given CDC guidelines of a cumulative time of 15 minutes for persons within six feet of one another.
