### Indiana Association of Environmental Professionals (INAEP) Scholarship

#### Call for Applications

This scholarship was established by the INAEP to promote and support the training of new Environmental Professionals in the State of Indiana. The INAEP was established in 2006 to bring together Environmental Professionals from interrelated disciplines to create an open forum for the exchange of ideas and innovation within the field.

This scholarship is to support a student who has an interest in an environmentally oriented field and who has demonstrated a commitment to a career in this area. The INAEP advocates the pursuit of knowledge in an ever-expanding field and wishes to assist those students who are choosing that path.

The recipient of this scholarship will be selected in the <u>spring</u>, and the \$1,000.00 award will be available for the 2011-2012 academic year.

#### Qualifications include:

- 1. The recipient will be an undergraduate student interested in a career within an environmental field with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher. Eligible students shall submit an application, which includes an essay, transcript and two letters of support. Through the application process, students should provide evidence of sincere interest in attaining a career within the environmental realm.
- 2. The recipient must meet full-time enrollment requirements and will be at least a second year student (or equivalent) as defined by their respective institute of higher learning.
- 3. The recipient must attend one (1) INAEP General Membership meeting, held in Indianapolis, Indiana, where they will be formally recognized for their accomplishments.
