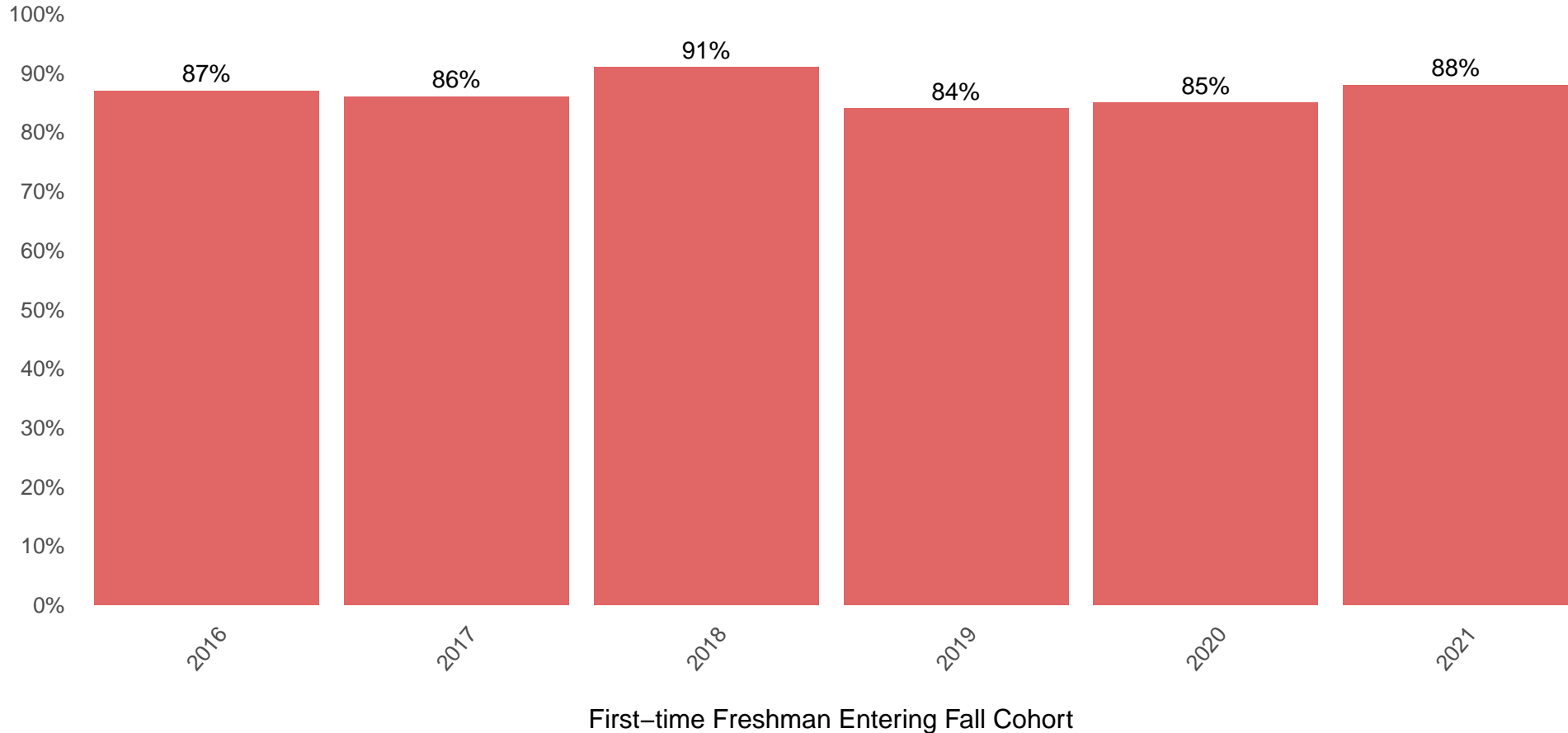


Wabash College Freshman to Sophomore Retention Rates

Overall



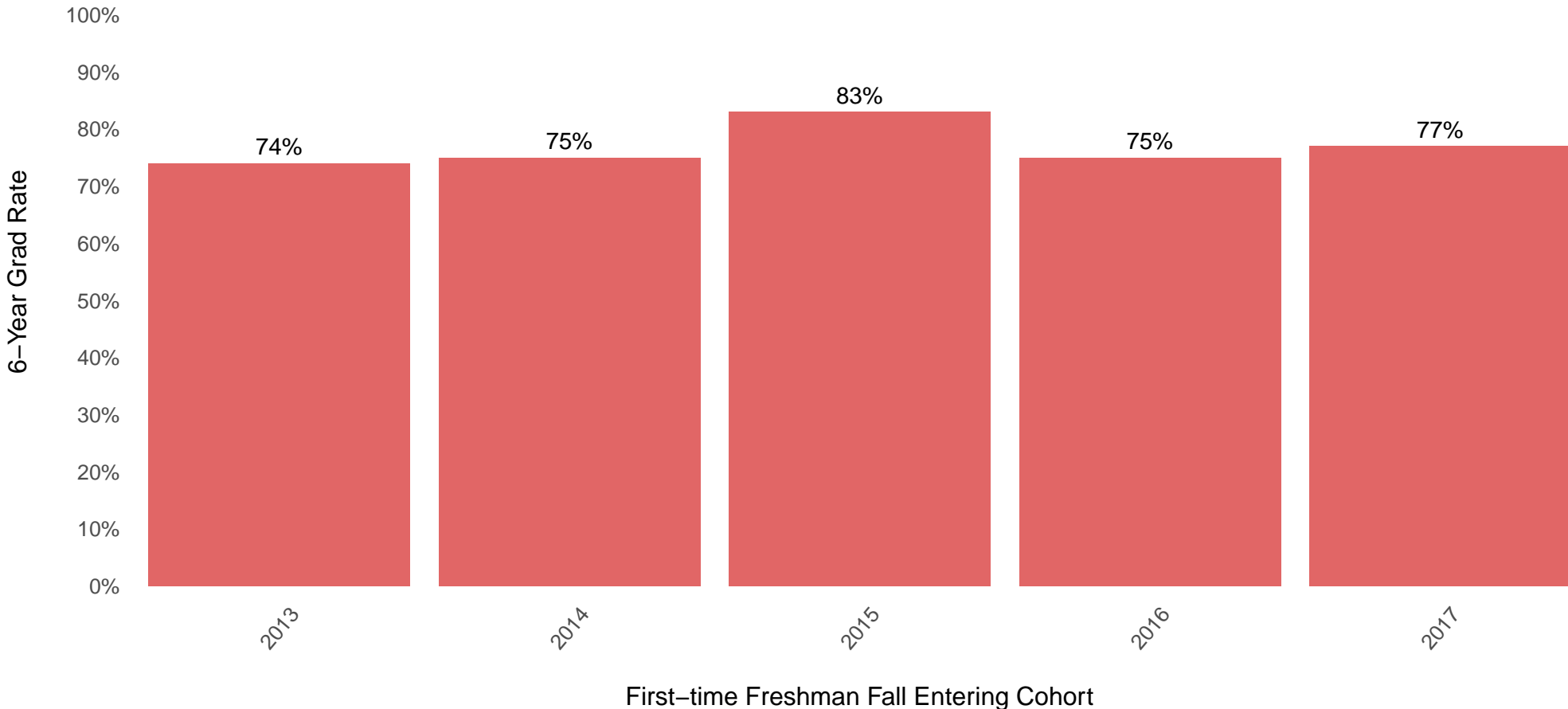

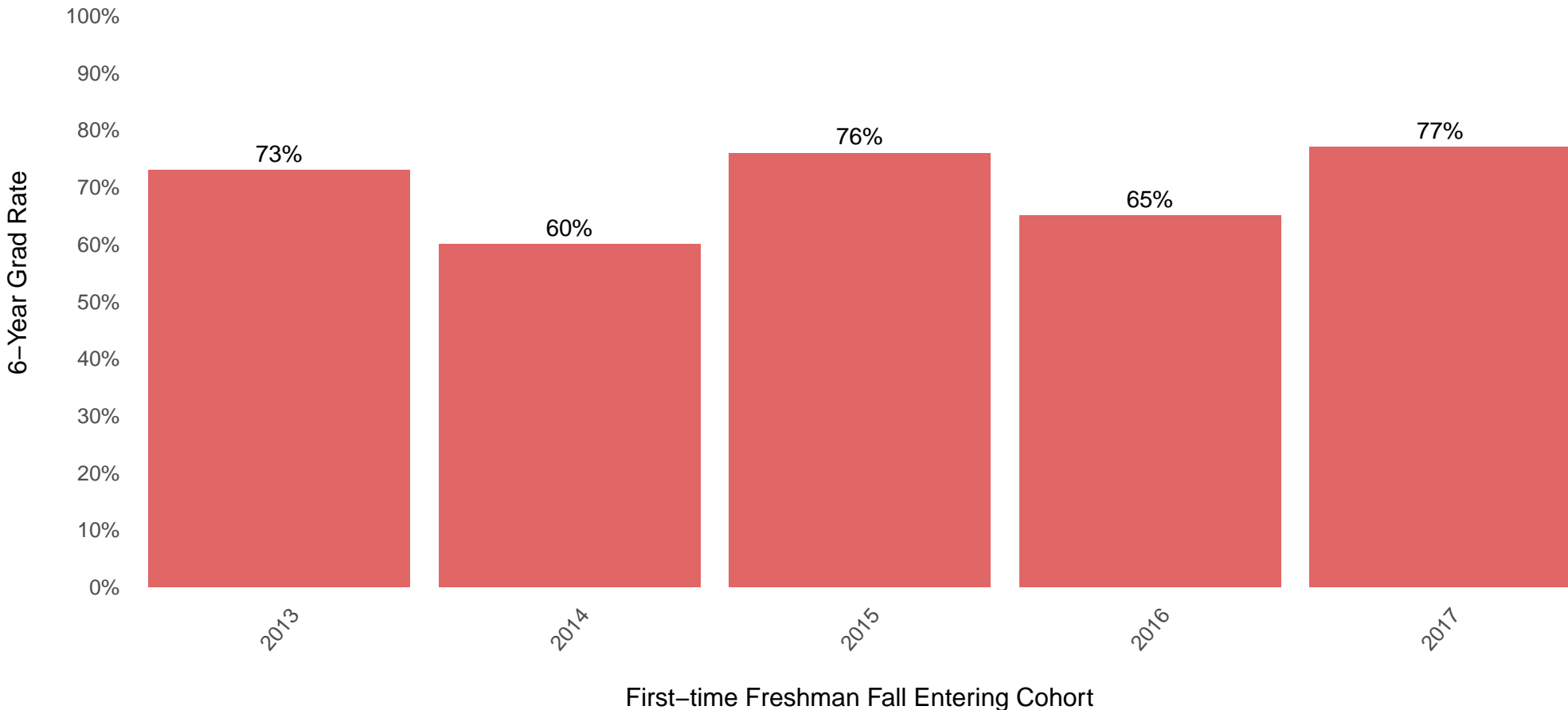

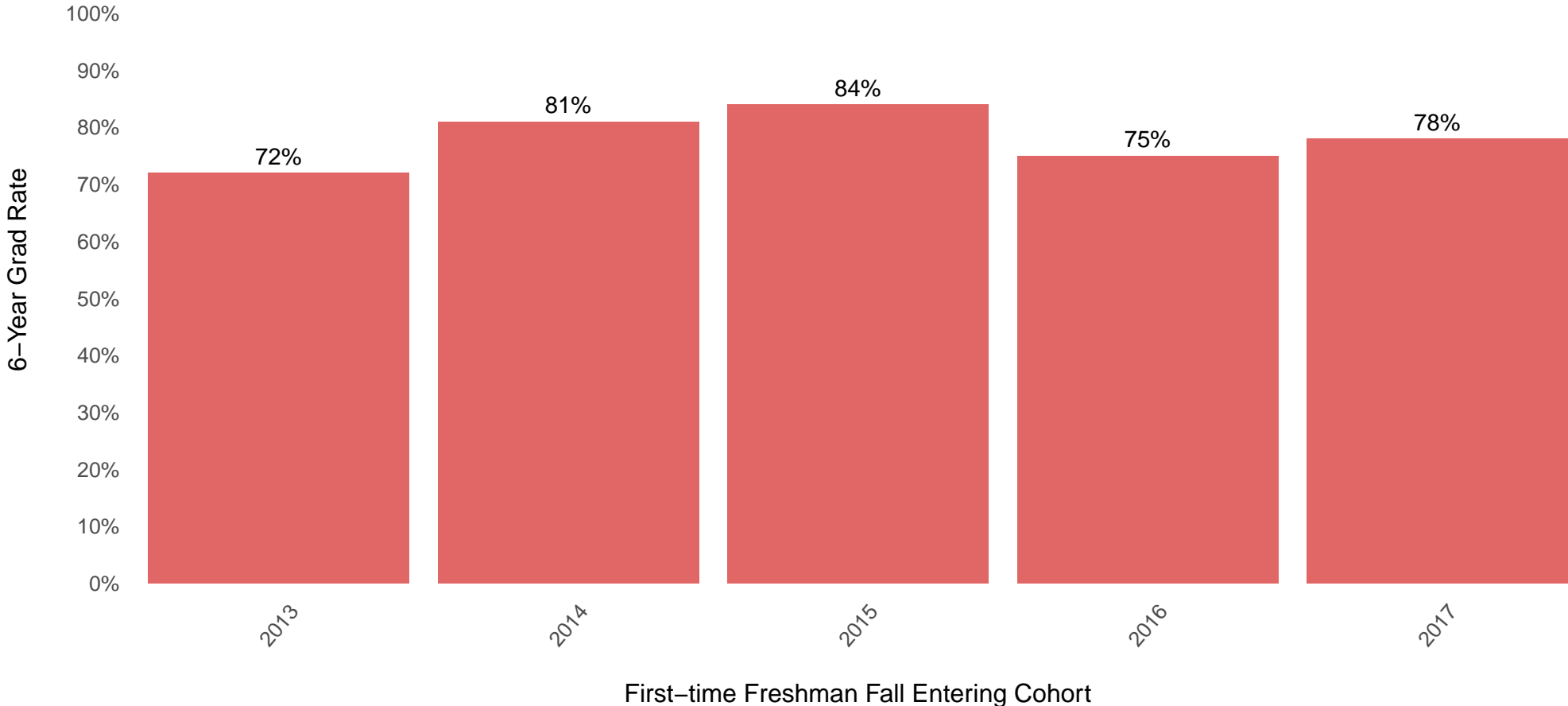

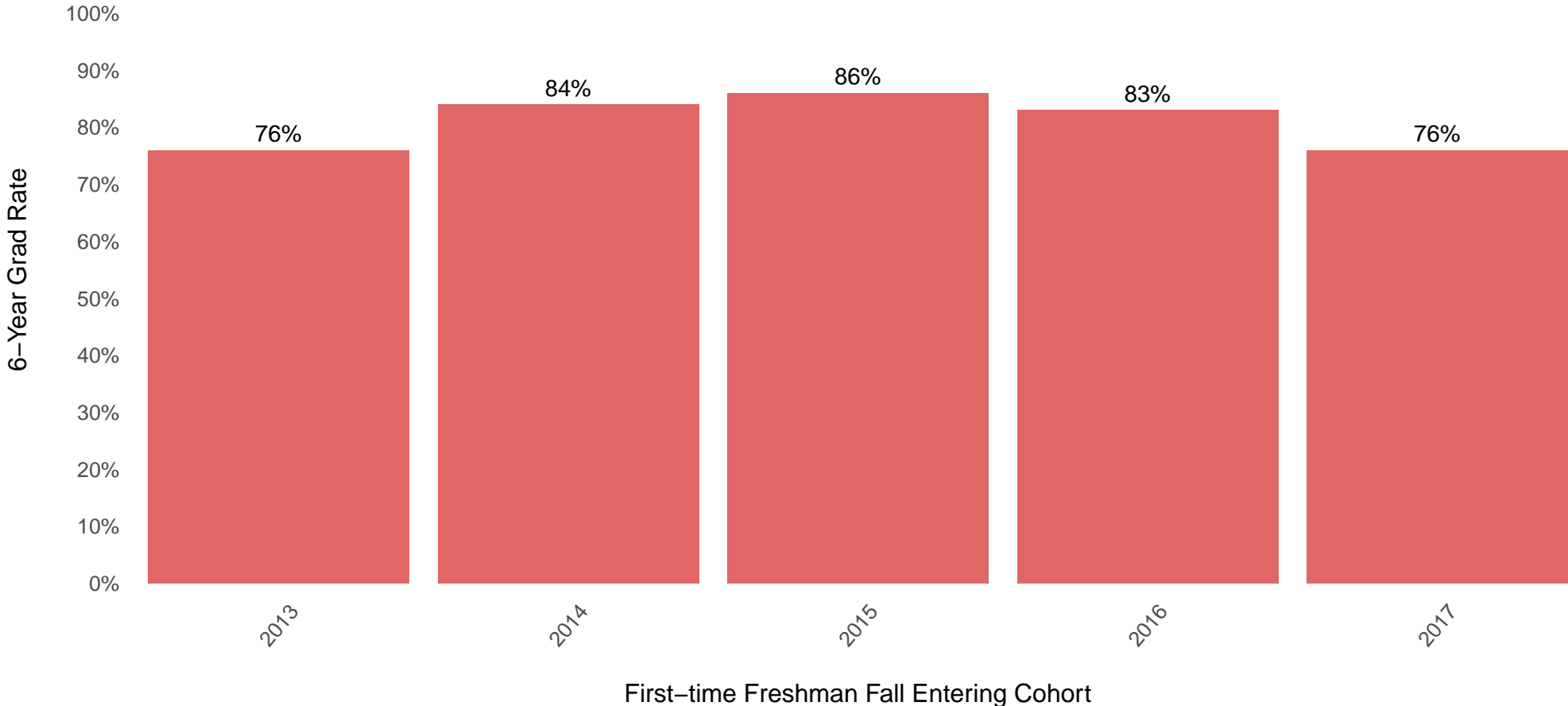

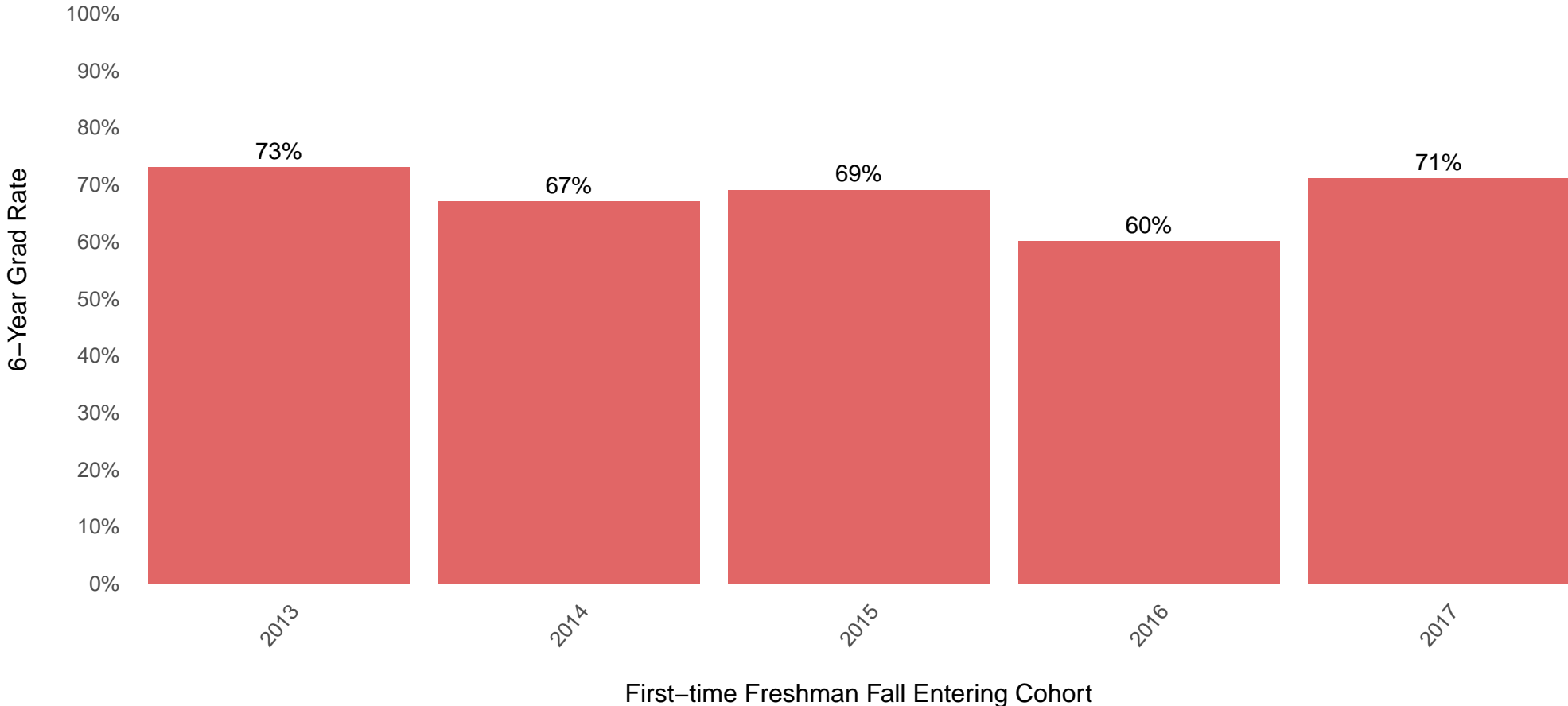

Wabash College 6–YR Grad Rate Black Students



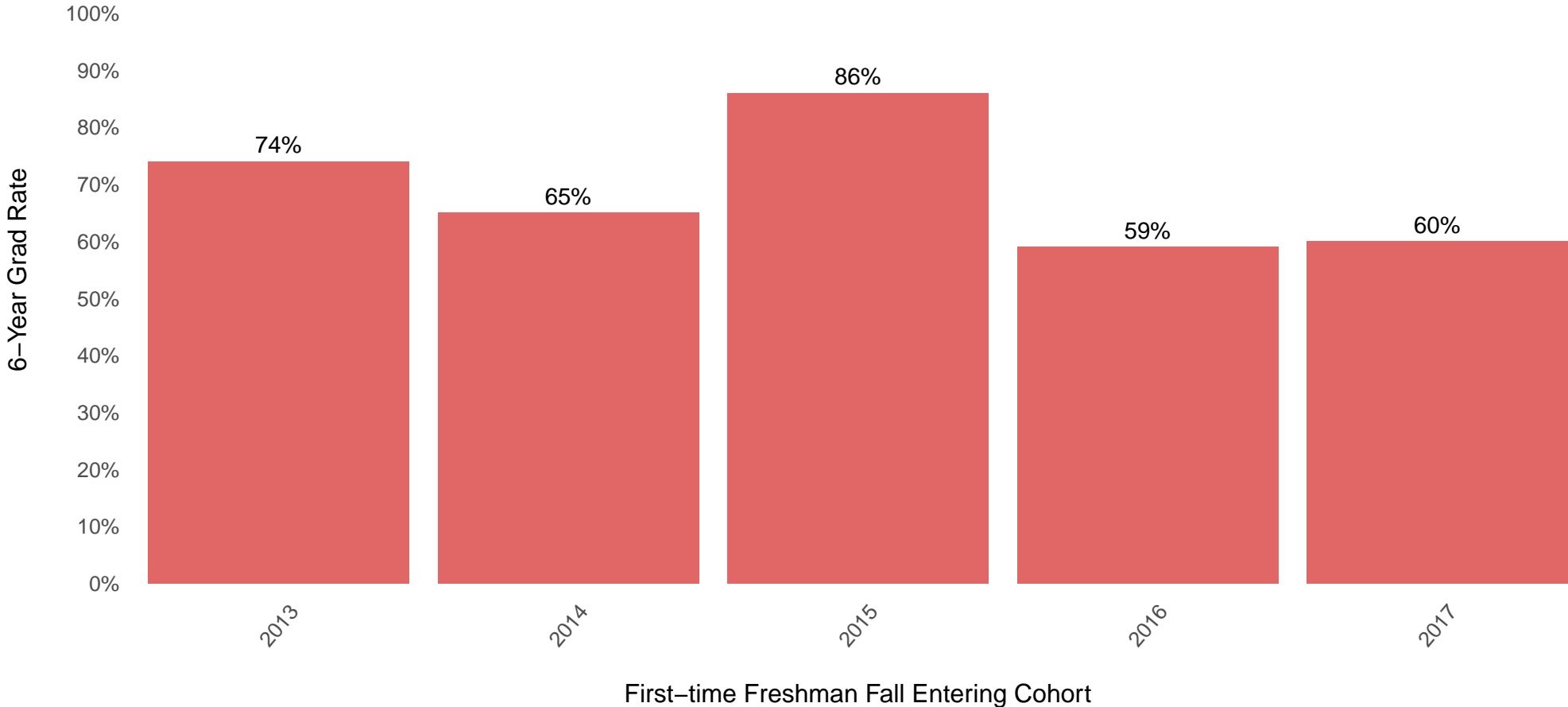

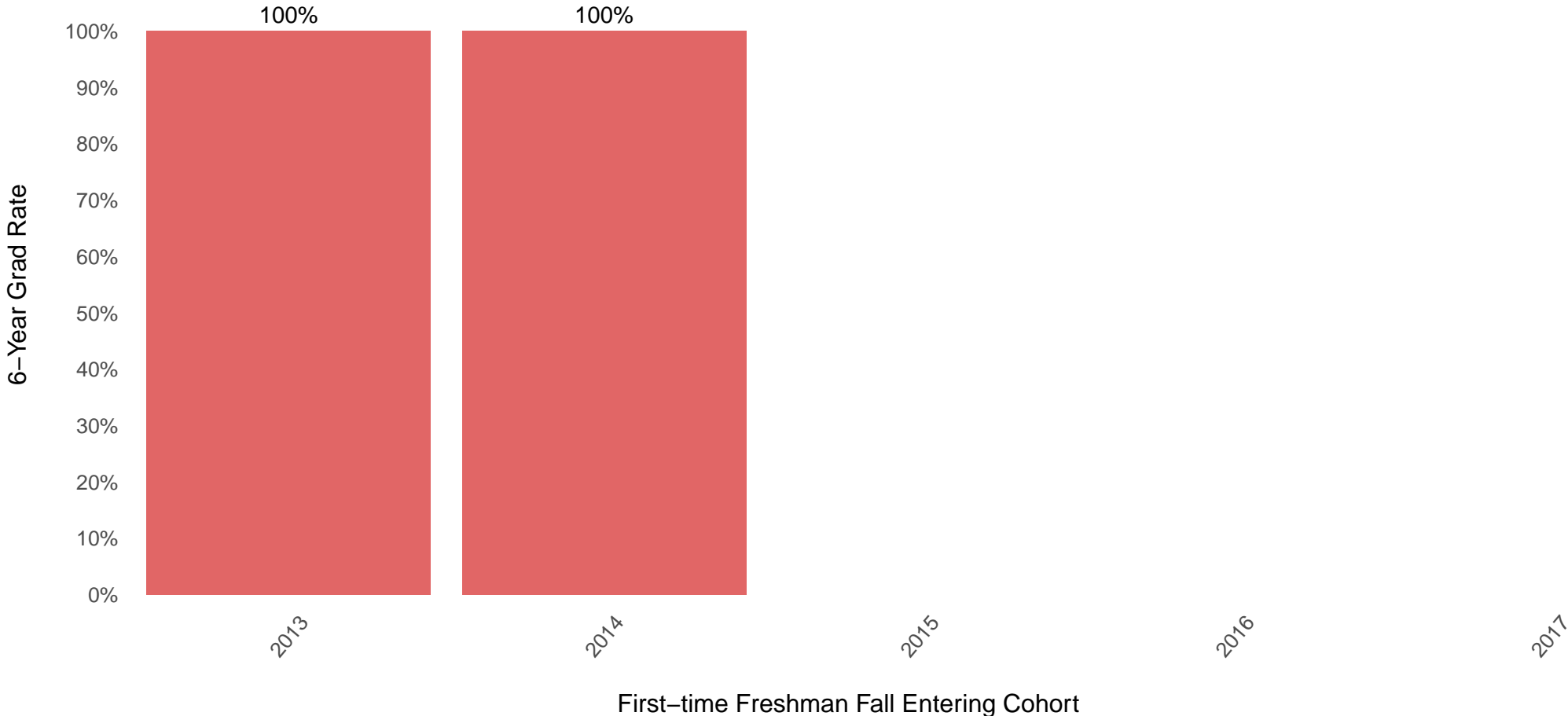

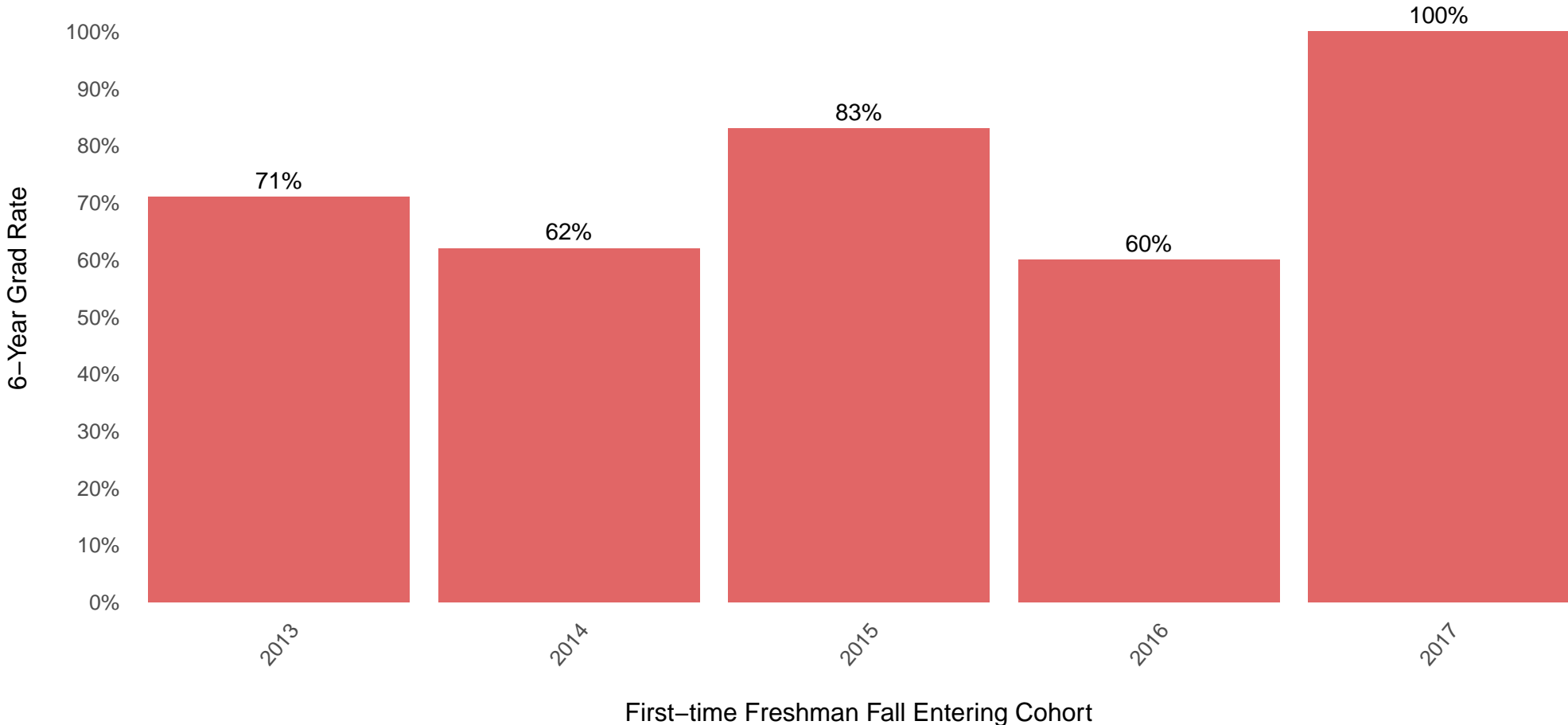

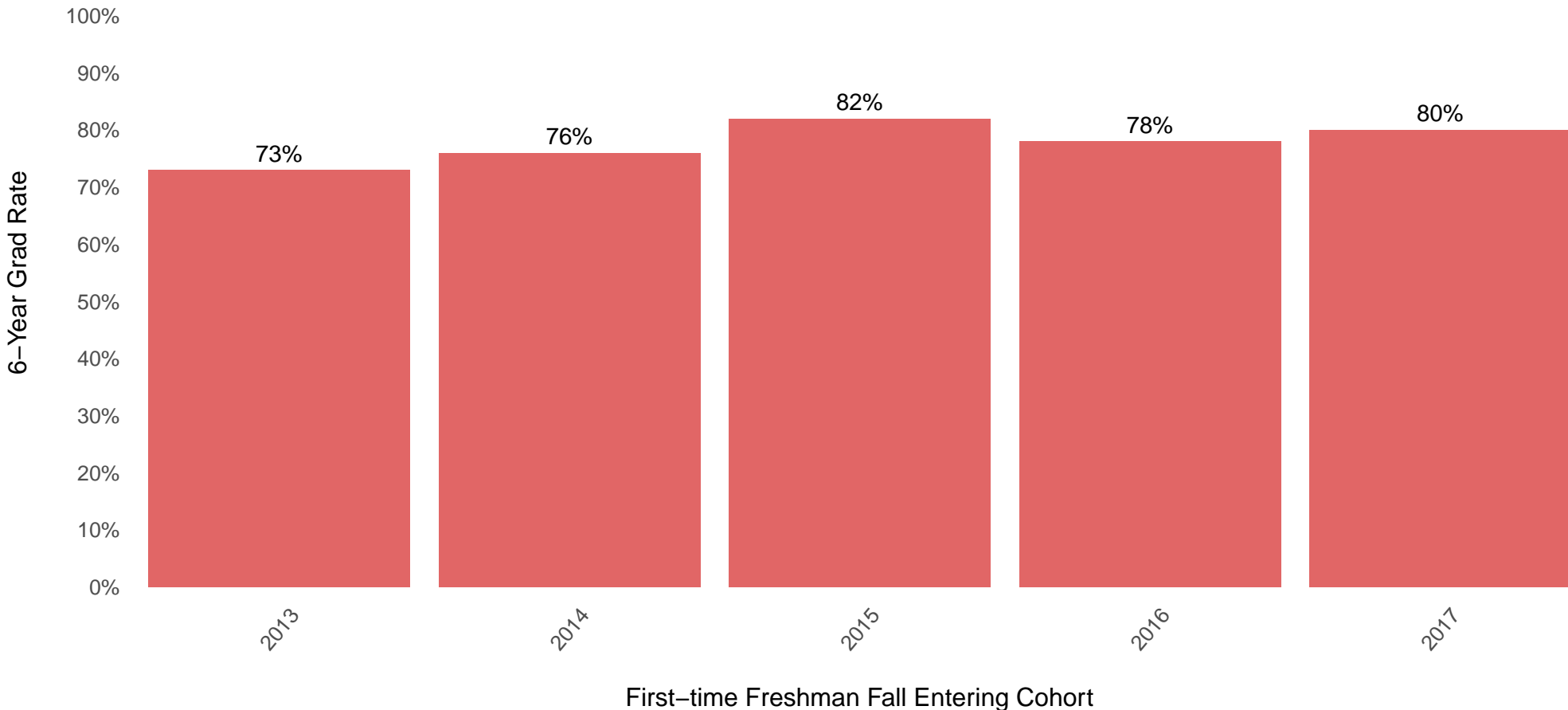

White Students



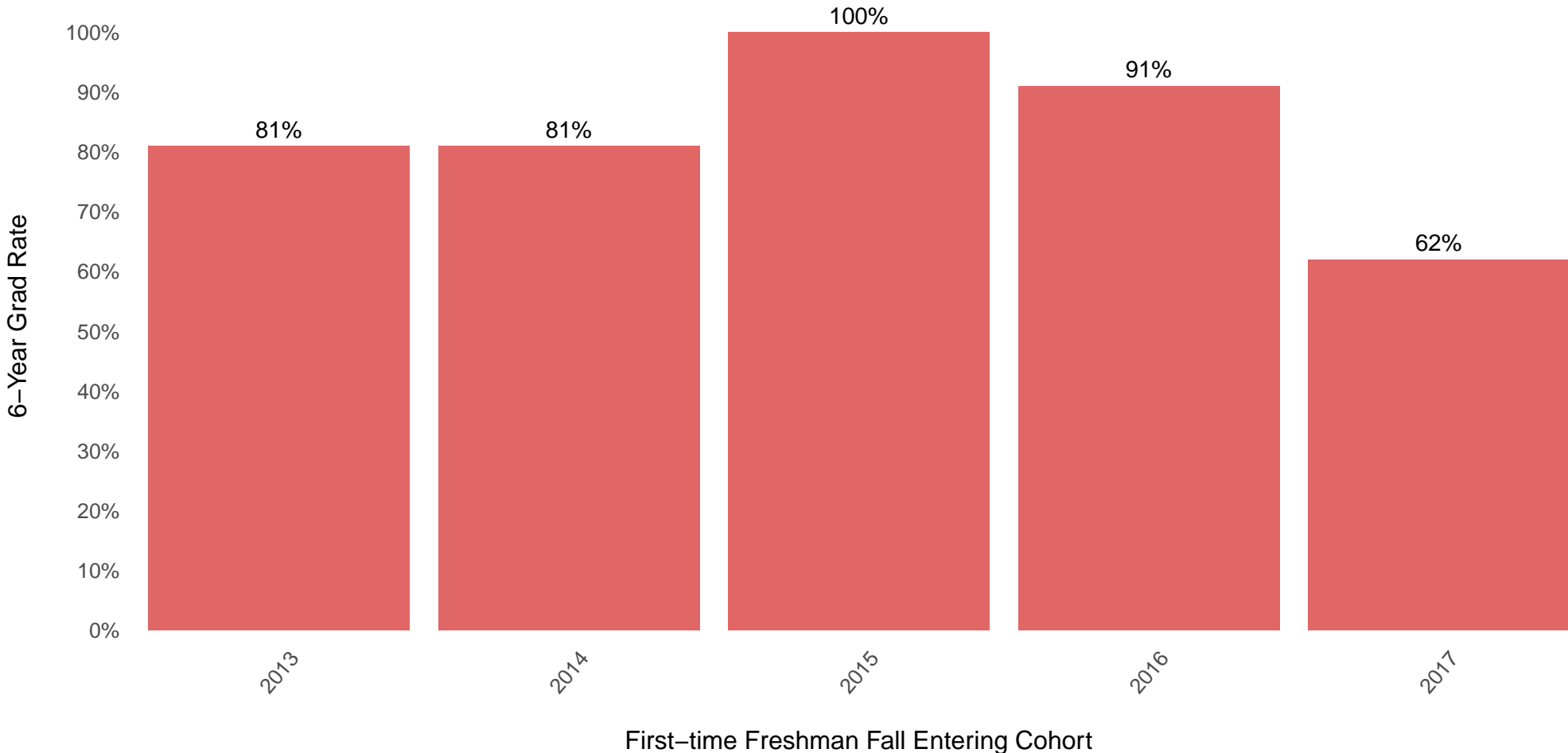

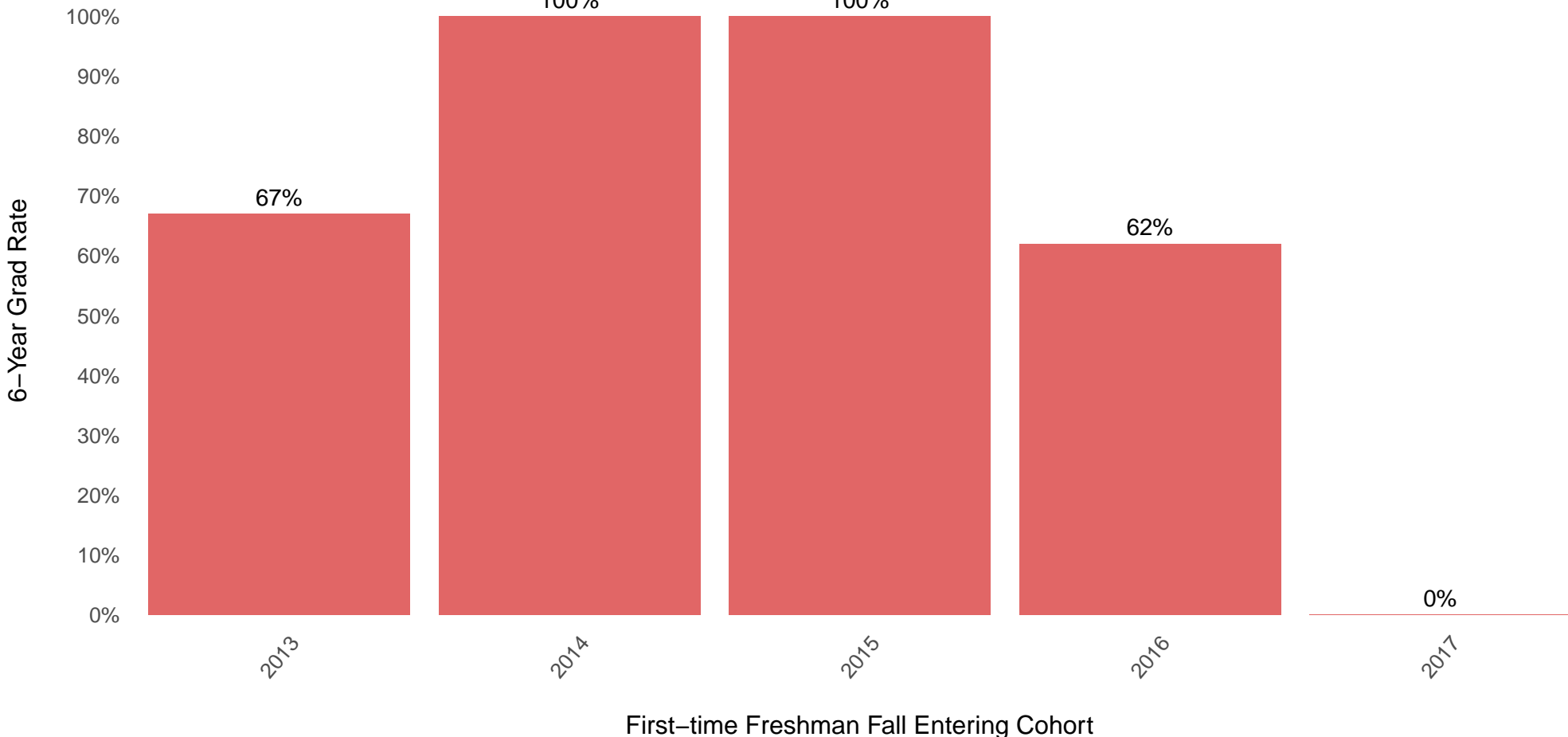
