

Wabash College Policy regarding Domestic Off-Campus Study Program Offerings

Wabash College recognizes the unique learning and immersive environments that domestic off-campus study programs (programs offered within the United States) can offer, and we endorse student participation in those programs which offer the following:

- **Specifically created for providing Liberal Arts students with an experience unlike that of their home campus**
- **An opportunity for immersive learning *unavailable on Wabash's campus*** (full-time laboratory setting, full-time internship, full-time research project, etc.)
- **The ability to transfer credits earned back to Wabash College**

Examples of these types of programs which have been approved in the past include:

- Associated Colleges of the Midwest, Newberry Seminar (Chicago, IL)
- Associated Colleges of the Midwest, Oak Ridge Science Semester (Oak Ridge, TN)
- Ohio Wesleyan University, New York Arts Program (New York, NY)

We cannot endorse domestic off-campus study programs that only involve a student enrolling as a guest student on another college or university campus to take classes there for a semester.
