



FIRE EVACUATION AND SEVERE WEATHER SHELTERING INFORMATION

MAIN CAMPUS BUILDINGS (Living Units Follow on Page 4)

ALLEN ATHLETIC CENTER: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group into the Chapel to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the basement hallway and in the locker rooms.

ARMORY: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group into the Chapel to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the center basement hallway.

ARNOLD HOUSE (Career Services): In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Trippet Hall to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the center of the basement.

BAXTER HALL: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Chapel to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed down the stairs to the basement and shelter in the basement hallway near the elevator.

CALEB MILLS HOUSE: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Lilly Library to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the Lilly Library basement.

CAMPUS SERVICES: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Chapel to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, shelter in the middle hall away from doors and windows.

CENTER HALL: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Hays Hall to report to the emergency



personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed either to the basement of Hays Science Hall (if there is time) or to the first floor of Center Hall and shelter in the center hallway.

CHAPEL: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Allen Center to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the center basement hallway.

DETCHON CENTER: In case of a fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Hays Hall to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the first-floor restrooms or basement area.

FINE ARTS CENTER: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Chapel to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the Experimental Theater. Small groups may also shelter in bathrooms on the main floor of the building.

FOREST HALL: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Lilly Library to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed either to the basement of Kane House Lilly Library (if there is time) or shelter in a ground-level room away from windows and doors.

GOODRICH HALL: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Chapel to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the basement hallway.

HAYS SCIENCE HALL: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Lilly Library to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the mechanical room.

HAYS ALUMNI CENTER: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Trippet Hall to report to the

emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, shelter on the lower level of Trippet Hall (if there is time) or in the basement.

HOVEY COTTAGE: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Lilly Library to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement of Kane House or Lilly Library (if there is time) or shelter in the conference room away from windows and doors.

KANE HOUSE: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Trippet Hall to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in an area away from windows.

LILLY LIBRARY: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Chapel into report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the Archives or Video Production Studio.

MALCOLM X INSTITUTE: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Allen Center to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the first-floor restrooms.

TRIPPET HALL: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to Hays Hall to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, proceed to the basement and shelter in the center basement hallway.

WABASH CENTER FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING IN THEOLOGY AND RELIGION: In case of fire, proceed from the room, out the nearest exit, and move at least 50 yards away from the building. You should join the other building occupants outside to make sure that everyone got out of the building okay. Then move as a group to the Fine Arts Center to report to the emergency personnel in charge. In the event of a severe weather storm, shelter in the rest rooms or in the first-floor hallway, away from windows and doors.

FIRE EVACUATION AND SEVERE WEATHER SHELTERING INFORMATION STUDENT HOUSING

Butler House (319 Crawford) and Seymour House (407 Crawford) – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the MXI parking lot. Please notify your R/A or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement of Williams Hall or shelter in the lowest level of the living unit away from windows.

Rogge Hall / North Lodge (322 Union) – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the Cole Hall parking lot. Please notify your R/A or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the case of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement of your living unit and shelter away from windows.

Williams Hall / South Lodge (404 Union) – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the southwest parking lot on Milligan Street. Please notify your R/A or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the case of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement of your living unit and shelter away from windows.

College Hall – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the Fine Arts parking lot and meet up with fellow residents. Please notify your R/A or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Martindale Hall – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the arboretum on the north side at least 50 yards away from your building. Please notify your R/A or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Morris and Wolcott – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the front steps of the Allen Center. Please notify your R/A or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

214 West Jefferson – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the north side of FIJI. Please notify your R/A or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the lowest level of your living unit and shelter away from windows.

Beta Theta Pi – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the north side of Wabash Ave. Please notify your president or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Delta Tau Delta – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the TKE parking lot. Please notify your president or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Kappa Sigma – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the FIJI parking lot. Please notify your president or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Lambda Chi Alpha – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the north side of Jennison Street. Please notify your president or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Phi Gamma Delta – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the west side of Grant Avenue. Please notify your president or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Phi Kappa Psi – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the north side of Cole Hall. Please notify your president or emergency personnel if you suspect someone has not exited your living unit. In the event of a severe weather alert, proceed to the basement and shelter away from windows.

Sigma Chi – In case of a fire, proceed out the nearest safe exit, and move to the west side of Cole Hall.
