

CARES Act: Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF)

- 1. An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students: Wabash College has signed and returned the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is \$405,462.

Wabash is in the process of developing a plan to best match the needs of our students with these funds.

The College proactively addressed student need through timely refunding of housing and food service costs and providing college funds to address student need at the time.
