Appointments:

Please call to schedule a time to be seen in the Student Health Center. This allows us to schedule an appropriate amount of time to see you or to perhaps give you advice over the phone. Walk ins will also be seen as time permits. You may also email the nurse.

Insurance:

All students are seen free of charge regardless of insurance status. If you require lab testing, X-rays, or referral to a specialist, eye doctor or dentist, you may incur additional charges. The college nurse will be available to answer your insurance questions.

After hours care:

For medical problems Monday – Friday that can't wait until regular hours at the Student Health Center, students may call the private office of Drs. Roberts and Douglas at 362-5789. Note that if you receive care outside the Student Health Center, you may be

responsible for payment if your personal insurance does not cover the care or the bill exceeds what is covered by the Wabash reimbursement plan. For weekend problems that can't wait until Monday, you may visit the Weekend Clinic at 1704 Lafayette Road, 359-2088, in the Sugar Creek Medical Center that is across the parking lot south of the hospital. The Clinic is open Saturday & Sunday 10:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. It is a walk-in clinic. You may also go to the St. Vincent Ambulatory Care Center that is open Monday – Friday 8:00am to 8:00pm and Saturday and Sunday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Be certain to take your insurance information with you. Note that neither of these locations is a substitute for the Student Health Center.

Emergencies:

For life-threatening emergencies call 911 or go to the Franciscan Health - Crawfordsville emergency room at 1710 Lafayette Rd., on St. Rd. 231 north of Crawfordville (765-362-2800).
